Please join us, Friday, March 15th, for a special evening of prayer as we meditate on the Stations of the Cross through a Taize-style prayer service.




What is Taizé Prayer?

Taizé is a form of Christian prayer originating from the ecumenical Christian community of Taizé in France. One is invited to rest in God through the singing of psalm verses and other simple chants, alternating with periods of silent reflection. It is a time to "Come Away and Rest for a While" Mark 6:31).
