MISSION STATEMENT

"As a diverse parish, the community of St. Helena's encourages parishioners to be good stewards through the interaction and involvement of all members with respect and dignity to the poor, the sick and those in need, as well as encouraging the youth to participate fully in parish life."

PARISH MEMBERSHIP All parishioners should be registered. Please register at the Rectory when you move into the parish and also notify the Rectory if you are leaving the parish.

SPONSOR LETTERS Church law mandates that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active Confirmed Catholic. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the church, is in a valid Catholic marriage, and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. We can only write letters of eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

BAPTISM Baptism is celebrated every Sunday at 1:30 PM except during Lent. Arrangements must be made in advance. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics. If sponsors are from another parish, they are to obtain a sponsor letter from their parish priest indicating that they are practicing Catholics.

MARRIAGE Marriage arrangements should be made at least one year in advance and prior to any social plans. Contact the Parish Office for all pre-marriage.

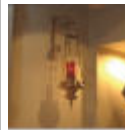

From the Pastor's Desk



Dear Parishioners,

Today's second reading from the First Letter of John, and the Gospel from John 15 both speak about love, Christian love. Christian love is not forced on a person. It doesn't come merely from physical attraction, or any other attraction. Love, true, lasting love, only results from the Love of Christ. And that love becomes a magnet. If a person loves the Lord, that love will attract other people who are seeking the Lord. Perhaps it will attract a person who is looking for someone to make a life with, certainly it will attract many others who are looking for the meaning to life.

Consider St. Teresa of Calcutta. Her work among the poorest of the poor spread throughout the world. Her religious order, the Missionaries of Charity, became the fastest growing religious order in the Church. Why were so many people attracted to Mother Teresa? Certainly they felt called to join her in making Matthew 25 a reality: "...when I was hungry you gave me food to eat, when I was thirsty you gave me drink, etc." But there was even more than this that attracted people to Mother Teresa. They were drawn by Jesus' love within her. Like a magnet, that love flowed through her into them. Then they attracted others to Christ. The love of Christ flowed through her into them. It still does.

We have been attracted by the magnetism of Jesus Christ. We know that saying that we love Him is not enough. We have to live His Love. In the Gospel Jesus uses this phrase: "Remain in my love." He tells us that we remain in His Love if we keep His commandments. But Jesus doesn't give a whole list of commandments. Jesus just gives one commandment: Love one another. If we love each other, truly, in the sacrificial love of the Lord, everything else falls into place.

Jesus Christ is the Elixir of Love. He is the potion that brings happiness. We pray today for the courage to love His Presence so much that His Love will flow through us and attract others to love as He Loves.

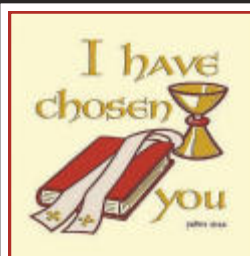

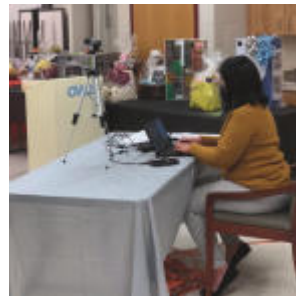

The Feast of Divine Mercy or Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated worldwide on the first Sunday after Easter. To help us as a parish prepare to celebrate this great feast with devotion, we are happy to announce that prayer cards with the Image of Jesus Divine Mercy on the front and the Chaplet of Divine Mercy on the back will be available for the taking at the entrances of the church beginning with the Triduum and as long as they last.

We hope that as many of us as possible will take advantage of this great opportunity to obtain the promises that Jesus made to St. Faustina and through her to each one of us.

THE CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY

The Chaplet is Prayed on a five-decade Rosary

1. **Make the Sign of the Cross**
2. **Our Father**
3. **Hail Mary**
4. **The Apostle's Creed**

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

5. The Eternal Father

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

6. On the Ten Small Beads of Each Decade

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

7. Repeat for the remaining decades

Saying the "Eternal Father" (5) on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion" (6) on the following "Hail Mary" beads.

8. Conclude with Holy God (Repeat three times)
Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.


