

MISSION STATEMENT

"As a diverse parish, the community of St. Helena's encourages parishioners to be good stewards through the interaction and involvement of all members with respect and dignity to the poor, the sick and those in need, as well as encouraging the youth to participate fully in parish life."

PARISH MEMBERSHIP All parishioners should be registered. Please register at the Rectory when you move into the parish. Our hours are Mon-Thurs, 9 AM - 4 PM, we close for lunch from 12:30-1:30 PM, and Fridays we are open until 12:30 PM. Also, please notify the Rectory if you are leaving the parish.

SPONSOR LETTERS Church law mandates that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active Confirmed Catholic who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the church, is in a valid Catholic marriage, and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. We can only write letters of eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

BAPTISM is celebrated every Sunday at 1:30 PM. Arrangements must be made in advance. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics. If sponsors are from another parish, they are to obtain a sponsor letter from their parish priest indicating that they are practicing Catholics.

MARRIAGE arrangements should be made at least one year in advance and prior to any social plans. Contact the Parish Office for all pre-marriage arrangements.



2025 LENTEN OBLIGATIONS

- 1. The days of both fast and abstinence are Ash Wednesday (March 5) and Good Friday (April 18).
- 2. The other Fridays of Lent (Mar. 7, 14, 21, 28, April 4, and 11) are days of abstinence.
- 3. Fasting in the Roman Catholic tradition means to limit oneself to one full meal with two smaller meals which together do not equal the size of your full meal, The obligation of fasting applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59.
- 4. Abstinence in the Roman Catholic tradition means to abstain from eating meat (beef, chicken, pork, turkey, etc.) The obligation of abstinence applies to all Catholics who have reached the age of 14.

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Today's readings help us to refocus on the spiritual in our lives.

St. Paul tells the Philippians, "our citizenship is in heaven". The spiritual is what matters. We have to allow God to transform our minds by His spiritual reality. The spiritual must transform the world. We come upon Jesus at prayer on the Mountain. Luke begins the account with the Lord at prayer. This is significant. The Lord is opening Himself to the presence of the Father. He is transformed, transfigured, into a state that reflects the glory of God. Moses and Elijah appear. Moses represents the Books of the Law, Elijah represents the Books of the Prophets. They come to speak to Jesus, the very Word of God. Of course, the disciples, Peter, James and John, don't understand this. They are still looking for a physical kingdom. The voice in the cloud is meant for them and us: "This is my Beloved Son, Listen to Him." We belong to the spiritual. We belong to God. We are made in the image and likeness of God. But the image of God, our capacity to be spiritual, is hidden deep within us. The Lord will reveal it, though, if we let Him. The Lord chips away on us. The negative drives within us are also chipped away, our anger, our greed, our lust, our jealousy.

We belong to the Kingdom of God. We are made in His Image and Likeness. We are physical and spiritual. We have our citizenship in heaven. Jesus Christ is transforming us into an everlasting gift to the Father. The Divine Sculptor's work will not be unveiled until our mission on earth is complete. What will we look like if we let Him complete His Work? Well, we also will be transfigured.

CHRISM MASS -TUESDAY, APRIL 15, 2025

On Tuesday, April 15, 2025, Bishop James F. Checchio will celebrate the Chrism Mass with the priests of the Diocese. At this Mass, all priests will make a Renewal of Commitment to Priestly Service to the Bishop and the people of God. The Bishop will also bless and consecrate the Holy Oils, which each parish receives for the rites of anointing.

The Oil of Catechumens is used to anoint infants and adults before their Baptism; the Oil of the Sick is used on the forehead and hands of the infirm in the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick; and Sacred Chrism is used to anoint the head of the newly baptized, the foreheads of confirmandi, the hands of a priest at his ordination, the head of a bishop at his ordination, and the altar and walls of new churches.

All are strongly encouraged to join in-person or via Livestream in the ancient, grace-filled Chrism Mass at the Cathedral of St. Francis of Assisi in Metuchen at 4:00 PM.
