From the Diocese:

Parishioners may remain at home to watch a live stream of Mass:

- (i) those who are sick;
- (ii) those who are 65 or older;
- (iii) those who have been advised by health care workers or caregivers to not attend Mass;
- (iv) those who sincerely believe that attending Mass will jeopardize their health or the health of a person with whom they reside.

For those physically attending Mass.

- **Do Not let your guard down!**
 - Continue to follow recommendations to stay safe
 - Follow the MASS protocol as well as the MASK protocol to continue to keep all of us safe.
- **Mass Protocol**
 - Limited seating (50% of capacity). Overflow will be directed to Lee Hall.
 - Please use hand sanitizer located at the entrances.
 - Follow directions of ushers for seating/spacing.
 - Everyone should wear a face mask/covering.
 - Offering baskets will be at the base of the altar.
 - No singing, only organ music
 - No congregating after Mass
- **Mask Protocol (applies to Sunday and Daily Masses)**
 - Everyone should wear a face mask/covering.
 - Homemade, bought, face scarf, bandana masks are all okay.
 - Wearing a mask has a two-fold purpose.
 - To prevent your “germs” from being broadcasted to the rest of us.
 - To help prevent you from inhaling other’s “germs.”
 - Put your mask on before you leave your car.
 - Leave your mask on until you return to your car.
 - To receive Holy Communion wearing your mask.
 - Receive the Host in your hands.
 - Lift the edge of your mask and consume the Host.
 - It **must** be consumed while standing at the altar.
 - Lectors should uncover their face **only** while proclaiming the Word.

"A Sacrificial Gift"

How can I determine how much is a "sacrificial gift"? One way to determine a sacrificial gift is by relating your gift to your income. Some people reach into their pocket to see what is left from Saturday night.

As a good steward, you are being asked to consider donating one hour (2 1/2%) or two hours (5%) of your weekly income. As circumstances change, increase gradually toward the ideal of 10% to your church and other charities. Some will be able to do more while others may need to do less.

There are two important points: first is that your gift be a sacrifice and second is that you relate your donation to your income. If your income is \$1000/week or \$4333/month then a weekly sacrificial gift would be 2.5% = \$25, 5% = \$50 and 10% = \$100.
