



My dear and beloved people of God,

The Bishop has issued a September update to the Covid-19 protocols for the Austin Diocese. All parishes must return to their original Mass and Confessional schedule by the first weekend in October 2020. For us that means we will return to having a Vigil Mass at 6:00pm on Saturdays at St. Charles Borromeo, beginning with October 3rd.

The State of Texas has increased capacity attendance 75% for churches. We have enough social distance (OLOL) and adequate overflow capacity in Lee Hall (St. Charles) with our updated technology providing real time sound and video on the large screen TV, for everyone to attend that wishes to do so.

Other protocols for masks, household social distancing, reception of Holy Communion on the hand and no singing will remain in place until further notice.

We still encourage the following parishioners to remain at home and join the community through our livestreamed Mass at 9:00 AM: (1) those who are showing signs of being ill (COVID-19 or otherwise); (2) those who have an underlying health condition making them vulnerable, or (3) those who live with or care for anyone in the previous two categories. If you do not fit any of the situations above, you are "highly" encouraged to return to being physically present for Mass. Parishes may no longer save the recorded Mass on social media. Participating in the Mass via livestream is to be done concurrent and together with the parish community in the church.

We are looking forward to having all our parishioners join in celebrating Mass this weekend and every weekend going forward:

- Vigil Mass Saturday, October 3rd at 4:00 pm OLOL
- Vigil Mass Saturday, October 3rd at 6:00 pm St. Charles, Kingsland
- Sunday, October 4th 9:00 am St. Charles, Kingsland
- Sunday, October 4th 9:00 am Livestreamed from St. Charles, Kingsland

"A Sacrificial Gift"

How can I determine how much is a "sacrificial gift"? One way to determine a sacrificial gift is by relating your gift to your income. Some people reach into their pocket to see what is left from Saturday night.

As a good steward, you are being asked to consider donating one hour (2 1/2%) or two hours (5%) of your weekly income. As circumstances change, increase gradually toward the ideal of 10% to your church and other charities. Some will be able to do more while others may need to do less.

There are two important points: first is that your gift be a sacrifice and second is that you relate your donation to your income. If your income is \$1000/ week or \$4333/month then a weekly sacrificial gift would be 2.5% = \$25, 5% = \$50 and 10% = \$100.
