FR. STEPHEN

PASTOR

My Dear Family,

As per norm, it is a great pleasure to pen a piece for the parish bulletin and your personal reading edification. The joy of the Gospel leads me to reflect upon the paradox of the Gospel, the very heart of the Christian message, the Beatitudes. So, I have been told, anyway. Shall I be quite honest? As a kid, these didn't make much sense to me and I felt like they didn't make much sense to the people teaching me either because they never seemed to explain it well or in an attractive way. I believe I now know what the problem was.

It was that they did not want to talk about suffering.

Life, my brothers and sisters is hard, and here in America, we have it pretty good. In the 1990s, when I was coming up, we were busy living a plastic existence (shiny and bright, sanitary, but with no real reality), and the dangers of the world were hardly spoken about to middle-class kids. At best, we got a Saturday morning tv special about not using drugs. In that world, where everything was "perfect," (it wasn't by the way), there was no reason to suffer for the sake of righteousness-we had succeeded without struggle, the "end of history" was in sight, and who needed a Second Coming anyway? And as a timid child I learned the wrong definition of meekness- perceiving it as the abandonment of reason for naivete. Not a useful lesson for a child trying to be faithful in a hostile world.

We were too comfortable.

You tell me that I will have to be persecuted for sake of the name? I tell you I still remember the sermons as a child where the pastor said he couldn't imagine any of us being called to martyrdom. But the climate has definitely changed in the last 9 years. Before, no one could tell me what it means to mourn, but now I know-I have lost much that I cared for and loved over the decades of my (relatively) short life. But I know now. And now, by His grace, the Beatitudes make sense.

I can preach to you a supernatural blessing beyond our wildest imaginings. God did not become man to end history, but to fulfill it. God knows the littlest and worst of us by name and has a promise of hope for each one. For everyone, whoever clings to Him. Even if the world is trying to stamp them out. God has a place for the men and women who have power but do not wield it like a club but instead allow themselves to be directed by the One who is "humble of heart," (the true definition of meekness). God is purity, and those who cling to it as the world offers a gluttony of impurity will see what they were actually made to see.

The price of comfort is finally too high for us, my brothers and sisters. In truth, it always was, but now they are demanding the total abandonment of Christianity. And now, I am truly joyful. For I know that He who has saved me from my sins, who has always kept His promises to me, has already known the awfulness that awaits us in our lives, and has promised rewards beyond description should we hold fast to the Good. Hold fast to Jesus Christ.

I trust Him. Do you?

2023-2024 PRESCHOOL ENROLLMENT

Welcome to Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Preschool! It is time to enroll for the 2023-2024 school year. We are excited to have your three or four-year old as part of our school family. This year our Class Selection Form will be completed and submitted online through SurveyMonkey. **You will need to complete a separate online Class Selection Form for each student you are enrolling.** The link to our online Class Selection Form will be available on our school website under the Admissions Tab beginning at: **9:00am Tuesday, February 7th**

Similar to our K-8 enrollment process, EVERYONE will enroll at the same time during a **Priority Registration Period**. Our Preschool Priority Registration Period will be for 8 days and begin at: **9:00am Tuesday, February 7, 2023 and continue through 11:59pm Tuesday, February 14, 2023**

As online class selection forms are submitted, they will be timestamped with the date and time of submission. We will then separate them into the four categories based on the following priority placement:

1. Current Preschool Families
2. Current K-8 Only School Families
3. St. Elizabeth Parishioners
4. Non-Parishioners.

Beginning at 12:00am Wednesday, February 15, 2023, preschool registration becomes Open Registration. Students will be enrolled in the order that their online Class Selection Form is submitted. No priority classification will be given to class placement in classes where there are openings.

Please note: Your child must be three years old or four years old by September 1, 2023 for all programs.

Classes are filled on a first come, first serve basis. After the class is filled, we will place your child on a waiting list and notify you if an opening becomes available.

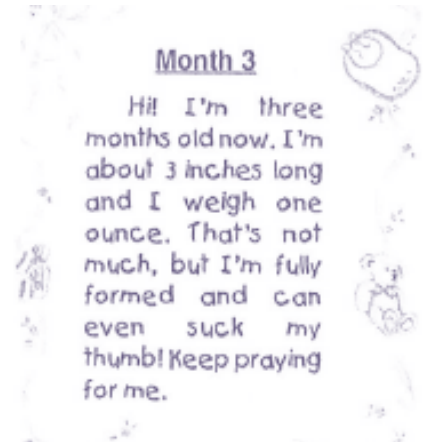
