

MANY SOURCES OF INFORMATION

Do you feel like you know well what is happening in the parish? Our parish feels more and more like a beehive, full of activity. It is so encouraging to see so many people gathering at our parish for many different events each week. However, it can be really easy to miss things as well if we aren't making sure to check the bulletin each week. This resource continues to be the most effective way of sharing lots of information with you in one place. If you are away for a weekend, you can access our bulletin in a digital form online, and it is important and helpful to do so. The other most important thing to be a part of is our parish Flocknote communication system, which can use phone or e-mail (or both). You can do this at our website, on the same page for parish registration (in the left column).

There are a few things I would like to highlight, although I will never be able to keep up with everything. First, the end of this month we will have three nights focused on the Eucharist and the power of Jesus to heal us in this sacrament. This is part of the Eucharistic Revival of our country, and in preparation for a year from now when we will do another "40 Hours" event in conjunction with every parish in the diocese. Please try to come for the evening program whenever possible, and sign up for times of Adoration (especially for the heroic night shifts). The Lord will certainly bless our parish for these days of intentional devotion to the Eucharist.

Secondly, don't forget to plan for a photography session for our parish directory. This info has been in recent bulletins. Also, we will need volunteers to help coordinate those days.

Thirdly, as Lent approaches, consider a Small Faith Community for yourself and even for your friends who do not know God but show an openness to religious sentiment. You could form your own group and watch the videos together with the provided discussion questions. Sign up and we will help you coordinate the program. If you want to join with fellow parishioners, you can form a new group or simply include the days/times that you would be available to meet with a group.

And last but not least, I am going to lead a pilgrimage to the Holy Land next year. If you would like to join in this pilgrimage from March 4-14 of 2024, please look in the next upcoming weeks for more information and reserve your spot.

WHAT FAMOUS SAINT ONCE MOVED, IF NOT THROUGH, VERY NEAR OUR PARISH'S BOUNDARIES?

Holy people have indeed passed through Aboite Township and include a well-known saint. Among those celebrated by our Catholic Church is Saint Theodora Guerin who having started her journey from St. Mary's of the Woods near Terre Haute, glided along on a canal boat to Fort Wayne in the 1840s. She made the journey to come to Fort Wayne at the invitation of Monsignor Benoit to establish our first Catholic schools. Mother Guerin, of the Sisters of Providence St. Mary's of the Woods, had to have passed our parish grounds a mere two miles to the south. By establishing the first Catholic school in Allen County our own St. Elizabeth Elementary School can claim a legacy of the celebrated Saint Mother Theodora Guerin.
