PIONEER SPOTLIGHT

This week's Pioneer spotlight features Mrs. Samantha Verslype. Mrs. Verslype is our Middle School Resource Teacher and Coordinator of Student Services. She attended St. Joseph Catholic School on Brooklyn Avenue and then Bishop Luers High School. For college she attended Purdue University where in addition to earning her Special Education Mild Disabilities degree, she met her husband Mike. The Verslypes settled in Fort Wayne where Mrs. Verslype began her teaching career. Her first teaching job was as a Resource teacher at Huntertown Elementary and although she enjoyed it, she missed the Catholic school setting to which she was accustomed. Fortunately, Miss Schreiber, the Principal at St. Joseph at the time, had an opening for her. Mrs. Verslype spent the next 4 years teaching 4th grade followed by teaching PE before opting to stay home with her two young sons. She stayed home, raising her family, for 14-years before going back to teaching. Returning to St. Joseph, Mrs. Veryslype taught Middle School Math for three years. Four years ago, we were fortunate that Mrs. Verslype

came to SEAS and settled in as our Middle School Resource teacher. Last year, the responsibilities of our Coordinator of Student Services was added to her responsibilities. Mrs. Verslype has stated that "this is my favorite teaching job ever! I love getting to work with many students each day. My role here as a Resource teacher allows me to plug-in to the different classrooms or take small groups out of the classroom. I teach reading/writing classes with each of the grade levels in 6th-8th grade and I enjoy that very much! One of my goals as a teacher is to help students become independent learners. They learn to be independent by being curious and determined, using strategies and "tools" to work through tasks, and they learn how important it is to ask questions. My favorite part of being a Resource Teacher is when I get to see all of that come together for a student." Mrs. Verslype's favorite saint is Mother Mary, who she turns to daily. Her gentleness, strength, and faith are inspiring. She enjoys reading about Mother Mary's many apparitions and miracles throughout the world. When not teaching you can find Mrs. Verslype in the kitchen trying a new Joanna Gaines recipe or outside working in her flower beds! If she could work outside every day, pulling weeds and puttering around with her plants, it would be heaven on earth! Luckily, husband Mike will work alongside her, though her children are not convinced how fun it is! The Verslypes have seven children, and are always busy with their activities. As a family, they like to go hiking and camping as often as possible. Mrs. Verslype mentions "it has been rewarding to help our kids learn to appreciate nature and being outside. We have so many fun memories of spending time together in this way." Thank you, Mrs. Verslype, for all you do for our students!




