PASTOR

BE RECONCILED TO GOD

The mission of the Gospel should always spur us forward. We should feel the call of the Lord to come and follow Him afresh in our hearts year after year. This is one of the main purposes of the Lenten season, as we hear Saint Paul cry out every Ash Wednesday: "We are ambassadors for Christ, as if God were appealing through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.... we appeal to you not to receive the grace of God in vain....Behold, now is a very acceptable time; behold, now is the day of salvation." (2 Cor. 5:20-6:2)

For this reason the church is traditionally described as always being reformed (Ecclesia semper reformanda est). The work of transformation within the church never ceases, as the unchanging faith in the triune God develops organically in its articulation and in its addressing of new circumstances.

Our parish will model this transformation in a visible way with renovations in the church from both parish savings and any donations from parishioners who wish to support it (we will not be doing a campaign). A parish survey was sent out electronically this week to gather some input from our parishioners, and it can be done by paper if preferred. I will value these impressions from the parish as a part of my discernment process for stewarding well the gifts of our parishioners. My hope is that these renovations will help to enhance the mission of the Gospel within our parish family, and be a visible sign of the vitality of our church community and a greater support to the receiving of God's grace in the Mass and at all times of prayer in the church. We exist to get people to heaven and to foster sanctity by growing intentional disciples. May our church never lose this mission or put other things in front of it.

I am currently exploring possibilities with the project team from Design Collaborative (two architects on the team are members here) and my team at the parish. I am starting the conversation on three areas: the sanctuary (front wall, tabernacle, altar, etc.), a choir loft, and a bell tower. These were all areas of interest eight years ago that were taken through the design phase almost to the point of getting bids for construction. They garnered significant support at that time and a lot of funds were donated to the parish campaign with the expectation of those things happening. It was rather disappointing or even upsetting to some in the parish. Besides these three areas, there are other things I would like to consider in renovations, and that is the purpose of the survey.

If possible, I hope to begin sanctuary renovations late June and have them finished prior to Christmas so that we have a full church space for that holiday. Then we can begin in other areas following that time. At least that is the timeline we are exploring at the present.

In about a month, we will have designs available for the parish to see and give feedback on through a town-hall meeting setting. More on that as we approach.

The church is always reforming. The individual Christian is always reforming. "We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.... we appeal to you not to receive the grace of God in vain....Behold, now is a very acceptable time; behold, now is the day of salvation." Let us allow this Lent to be a time of true transformation by God's grace. The mission of the Gospel is ever urgent.
