THE POWER OF PRAYER

You probably noticed that something was different in church today. The Stations of the Cross were repositioned to the front walls of the body of church instead of the back. Many thanks to Mark Stuerzenberger and Morris Fox for their roles on this. This required a little modification of the stations (some were wider than the space between the windows), removing a few inches of decoration on the edge of them while still maintaining the integrity of the station. With the beginning of the season of Lent, this will be especially helpful for our prayer as we are invited to contemplate the Lord's Passion in a more focused way during this time. Most importantly, this will help for Fridays when we pray the Stations of the Cross as a community (you are welcome anytime outside of Mass to pray them privately). These pieces of sacred art which help to tell the story of how Jesus "loved us to the end," and the greater visibility of them will be a great benefit to our personal prayer lives throughout the year. I invite you to allow your eyes to glance at them regularly and enter into the scenes in your imagination. This is one example of how sacred art can help our prayer come alive, and I hope you find it beneficial.

The Gospel for the first week of Lent always tells us of Jesus' 40 days in the desert. This echoes our beginning of this season of self-denial, dying to worldly pleasure so as to awaken the deeper hungers for truth, goodness, beauty, communion, and fulfillment - hungers for God Himself. In this Gospel account (this year from Matthew) we are able to see part of the strategy of the enemy, the devil, whom in another passage Jesus dubs the father of lies. The devil, who is a high being than us and thus more cunning of intellect, works tirelessly to sow his lies in our hearts as the first step in separating us from Our Father who is in Heaven. Notice the work Jesus does to reject such lies and overcome them. A great resource for any Catholic (or other Christian) to use is the approach developed by Neal Lozano is his book Unbound. On his ministry website it summarizes very well this problem and how they work through it:

"As children of a loving God, we were created to live in relationship with Him. Sin broke this relationship and separated us from God. Sin also opens the door for lies and bondage to enter our life, causing problems like fear, anxiety, hopelessness and shame. The Good News is that Jesus brought salvation and liberation by dying for our sins and setting us free from this bondage. But even after accepting this gift of salvation, we don't always fully experience freedom; we continue to feel anxious, afraid, guilty, or hopeless.

Unbound helps us respond to the good news of the gospel and apply truth to our lives using Five Keys:

1) Repentance and Faith 2) Forgiveness 3)Renunciation 4)Authority and 5) The Father's Blessing."

Go to the website HeartOfTheFather.com to discover more about this work and the five steps of prayer that can help us to get free from the bondage. I high recommend this prayer process for all of us, since the enemy is always sowing the seeds of his lies around us, and we may absorbing some of them without being aware. Also, you will notice step two, forgiveness, which they say is the antidote to the most common spiritual bondage people experience today - as so many cling to resentment and unforgiveness, resulting in spiritual paralysis. Who might you need to ask Jesus to help you forgive?

Lastly, did you know we have a team of parishioners trained in this prayer process? These fellow parishioners are available for praying with others who are ready to experience greater freedom and address any underlying wounds or spiritual blocks that may be impeding your growth in the Christian life. The Healing Prayer team would be a great way to enter into the work of forgiveness, uprooting lies, or healing of past wounds. May God bless you all with a wonderful Lent toward greater freedom and fuller love!

This week we are happy to spotlight Mrs. Leslye Yarde, one third of our outstanding 5th


