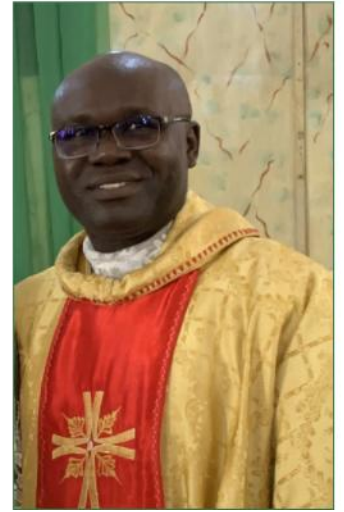

PRAY FOR NIGERIA

The word “desperation” is defined in part as “a state of hopelessness leading to extreme recklessness”. When one is desperate, he or she is in such a bad situation that he is willing to do “anything” to change it. This was the situation of the ruling class in Nigeria before the election of 25th of February this year. Majority of the youths of Nigeria decided to take their fate in their hands and decided to vote our bad governance, incompetence, injustice, incredibility and chart a course for a new Nigeria which they found in the presidential candidate of a hitherto unknown political party, the Labour Party. Mr. Pete Obi left the main opposition party to join the less known party because of what he called injustice and corruption and the youths of the country bought into his ideology of a new Nigeria and followed him massively. They called themselves “the Obidients” taking their name from their principal, Obi, the only Christian among the leading four candidates with a Muslim vice-presidential candidate, where the ruling party’s presidential candidate and his vice are both Muslims. Nigerians kicked against it but were ignored. They chose Obi because of his uncorrupted political track record as the former governor of Anambra state when he took the state from almost the last in the country to the first position in education, health care, roads, economy etc., never borrowed money and yet didn’t owe any salaries, pensions or gratuities which is not common in Nigeria. He still left 75 billion naira in the state purse while leaving office. No governor in Nigeria has ever done this.



The political party turned into a movement to set Nigeria free from the cabals holding her down. It became certain that Obi was winning the election of the 25th from the results being collated at the polling units and at the local government areas. In desperation, the ruling party deployed all arsenal within their power to rig the election. There was ballot box snatching, burning of ballot material, massive disenfranchisement, thuggery, police collusion and brutality, killing of innocent people, harassment and threats to life. Instead of electronic transmission of results, the election umpires changed to manual which gave them room to change and alter the results. The electoral umpires say that those who feel rigged out should go to court but, Nigerian courts, can they be trusted?

I know there is no perfect country, even here, but this is daylight robbery, and the youths are threatening to take to the streets in protest. Knowing my country, if this happens, people will die even as people have already died during the election. They do not care about human life and the law enforcement agencies can be trigger happy. In 2020, youths peacefully protested against police brutality in Nigeria tagged, “endSARS” and many people lost their lives. The announcement of the president elect, Bola Ahmed Tinubu was made by 4 am on Wednesday. One may ask, 4 am? During the campaigns, he had said that “it is his turn” to be president of Nigeria and they are really acting out the script. Please pray for my country because desperation can lead to readiness to do “anything” just to get to and hold on to power.

We were already in the mood for this election while I was at home on vacation and people were already suffering fuel scarcity, non-availability of naira because of currency redesign that was ongoing. I want to thank you all for your prayers while I was gone. In all situations we give glory to God and believe He is still in charge. May Jesus who was transfigured on the mountain in our gospel of today transfigure us to be just like Him.

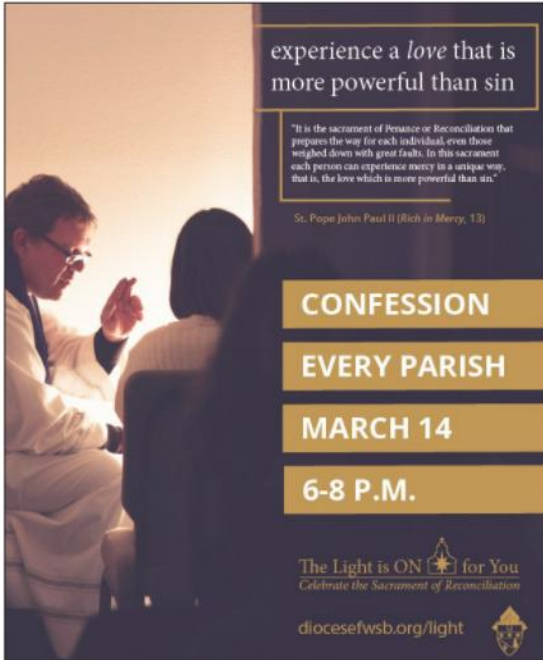

DECREE

**St. Patrick's Day and Friday
 Abstinence**

This year, Saint Patrick's Day, March 17th falls on a Friday of Lent when all Catholics who have completed their 14th year of age are obligated to abstain from meat. In response to several requests for a dispensation from the law of abstinence on March 17, 2023, I hereby decree the following for the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend:

Catholics in the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend may substitute for abstinence from meat one of the following acts on March 17, 2023, the Memorial of Saint Patrick:

- 1) Attendance at Holy Mass.
- 2) The recitation of the rosary for the intention of peace in the world.
- 3) One-half hour of prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

This commutation is meant to preserve the penitential spirit of a Lenten Friday while also allowing for the celebration of a great saint whose feast should be celebrated in a spiritual manner and not in a secular context.

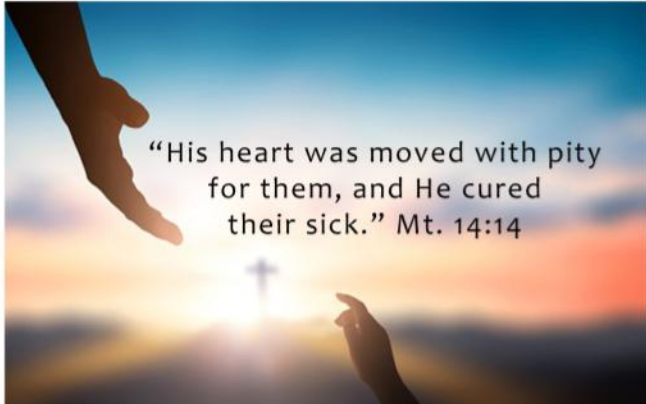
