THE CATHOLIC CHURCH WILL SURVIVE

At a conference this past January I heard a moving talk that ended with a quote from 54 years ago by a cardinal who eventually became Pope Benedict XVI. I think it is worth sharing with all of you. I hope it can help us to remember what we are here for and where we are meant to be headed. The quote below, edited for length, answers the question "what will become of the Church in the future?" Please reflect and pray with this long quote that follows:

The future of the Church can and will issue from those whose roots are deep and who live from the pure fullness of their faith. It will not issue from those who accommodate themselves merely to the passing moment or from those who merely criticize others and assume that they themselves are infallible measuring rods; nor will it issue from those who take the easier road, who sidestep the passion of faith, declaring false and obsolete, tyrannous and legalistic, all that makes demands upon men, that hurts them and compels them to sacrifice themselves. To put this more positively: The future of the Church, once again as always, will be reshaped by saints, by men, that is, whose minds probe deeper than the slogans of the day, who see more than others see, because their lives embrace a wider reality.

Unselfishness, which makes men free, is attained only through the patience of small daily acts of self-denial. By this daily passion, which alone reveals to a man in how many ways he is enslaved by his own ego, by this daily passion and by it alone, a man's eyes are slowly opened. He sees only to the extent that he has lived and suffered. If today we are scarcely able any longer to become aware of God, that is because we find it so easy to evade ourselves, to flee from the depths of our being by means of the narcotic of some pleasure or other. Thus our own interior depths remain closed to us. If it is true that a man can see only with his heart, then how blind we are!

How does all this affect the problem we are examining? It means that the big talk of those who prophesy a Church without God and without faith is all empty chatter. We have no need of a Church that celebrates the cult of action in political prayers. It is utterly superfluous. Therefore, it will destroy itself. What will remain is the Church of Jesus Christ, the Church that believes in the God who has become man and promises us life beyond death.

Let us go a step farther. From the crisis of today the Church of tomorrow will emerge — a Church that has lost much. She will become small and will have to start afresh more or less from the beginning. ... In contrast to an earlier age, it will be seen much more as a voluntary society, entered only by free decision. As a small society, it will make much bigger demands on the initiative of her individual members. ... But in all of the changes at which one might guess, the Church will find her essence afresh and with full conviction in that which was always at her center: faith in the triune God, in Jesus Christ, the Son of God made man, in the presence of the Spirit until the end of the world. In faith and prayer she will again recognize the sacraments as the worship of God and not as a subject for liturgical scholarship.

...It will be hard going for the Church, ...It will make her poor and cause her to become the Church of the meek. The process will be all the more arduous, for sectarian narrow-mindedness as well as pompous self-will will have to be shed. One may predict that all of this will take time. The process will be long and wearisome ... But when the trial of this sifting is past, a great power will flow from a more spiritualized and simplified Church. Men in a totally planned world will find themselves unspeakably lonely. If they have completely lost sight of God, they will feel the whole horror of their poverty. Then they will discover the little flock of believers as something wholly new. They will discover it as a hope that is meant for them, an answer for which they have always been searching in secret.

And so it seems certain to me that the Church is facing very hard times. The real crisis has scarcely begun. We will have to count on terrific upheavals. But I am equally certain about what will remain at the end: not the Church of the political cult, which is dead already, but the Church of faith. It may well no longer be the dominant social power to the extent that she was until recently; but it will enjoy a fresh blossoming and be seen as man's home, where he will find life and hope beyond death. The Catholic Church will survive., we still have our part to do. We must pray for and cultivate unselfishness, self-denial, faithfulness, Sacramental devotion and a life centered on Christ.

I then know that I have done my job. I also love all the extra activities that we do in 1st grade like Color Week, 100s day, Pet Day, Mr. Popper's Penguins, and Penguin Day, to name a few." First, Saint Francis of Assisi because of his love for animals and second, Saint Teresa of Calcutta for her work with the poor and her quotes of kindness, love, and hope. 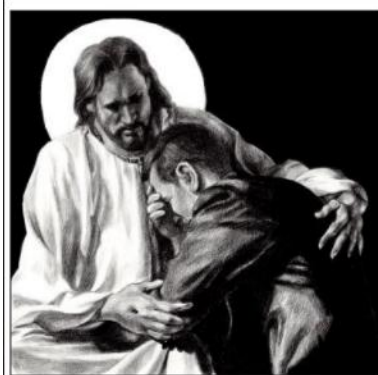

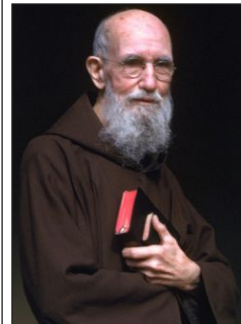

SAVE THE DATE

HOW WAS ST. ELIZABETH CHOSEN AS THE PATRONESS OF OUR PARISH?

On January 3, 1988, it was announced that the patroness of our parish would honor St. Elizabeth Ann Seton according to Today's Catholic of January 10, 1988. Word had come from the newly assigned pastor Rev. Robert Schulte that Bishop D'Arcy, leading a committee whose decision was based on the fact that, "she is a saint who represents such a diversity...a wife and mother who converted to Catholicism...later became a religious sister after her husband died...founded the American Sisters of Charity, and helped establish the Catholic School system in America." Further, Bishop D'Arcy noted, "that choosing a lay (non-ordained) woman was appropriate after the Synod on the Laity held in Rome in October 1987 examine the role of non-ordained Catholics in the Church, and particularly, the role of women."
