GREAT THINGS HAPPENING IN OUR PARISH

This week we will be receiving a sculpture replica of Michelangelo's masterpiece *Pieta*. This work of art will be unveiled to the parish after the Saturday evening Mass. All are invited to admire this beautiful piece of our cultural heritage before and after Masses in the weeks ahead. This is most fitting during this time of Lent that begins the period known as "Passiontide." Another Catholic custom is to veil the statues and paintings (excluding the Stations of the Cross) as you will see in our church next weekend. Since the *Pieta* will not be in Church, it does not require a veil during Passiontide. In fact, it really is one of the Stations: Jesus is taken down from the Cross. I pray that during this very solemn time of Passiontide, this sculpture will be a fruitful help to your prayer on how much the Lord Jesus loves you and on how He is present through the trials and sufferings we endure on this Earth, so often beyond our understanding, like Virgin Mary experienced at the Cross. If appreciated and supported by parishioners, there is a chance that this source of prayer and reflection could remain in our parish forever and given a permanent space in our church for all to see every week. It would be a beautiful element in the renovations we are working on.

The renovation designs are becoming complete for the three main elements we are exploring, and I look forward to sharing them with you. They represent a comprehensive, integrated plan for the church that could not happen all at once due to budget restraints (we are not soliciting pledges from parishioners but happily accept any free-will support) and because we do not wish to interrupt use of the church space any more than necessary. The "whole picture" of this design process is meant to ensure that the smaller parts of the project all make sense in the long-term and are properly unified by a single vision.

Feedback from the survey on other possible elements of the project was good. We received over 500 responses to the survey, and much of it was balanced with some in favor, others not. However, there was some support for keeping the current baptismal font and stations of the cross, as well as increasing the sacred art in the sanctuary. Parishioners also showed a clear desire for enhanced sound in church and for fixing/replacing the windows, and lastly a little support for putting hard surface in the aisles, but not for carpet under the pews. This last one left me wondering: was it because people saw the hard surface as easy to clean, or due to a lack of foreseen benefit to carpet under the pews? The greatest benefits I see are a softer surface to prevent loud noises (kneelers or children's toys) and greater sound-dampening to help prevent too much echo in church (audio enhancement). My last church always had carpet under the pews and we kept it that way when renovating.

Sorry to assault your attention with this information as we are supposed to be focused on upcoming Holy Week, but I know it is important to share them with you all. The point of all of the work we do for renovations is ultimately to provide an even better space for us to pray well, to encounter God and open our hearts to receive His grace within Mass and outside of it. Please keep your parish in your prayers for these last weeks of Lent!


PIONEER SPOTLIGHT




Revive Fort Wayne




