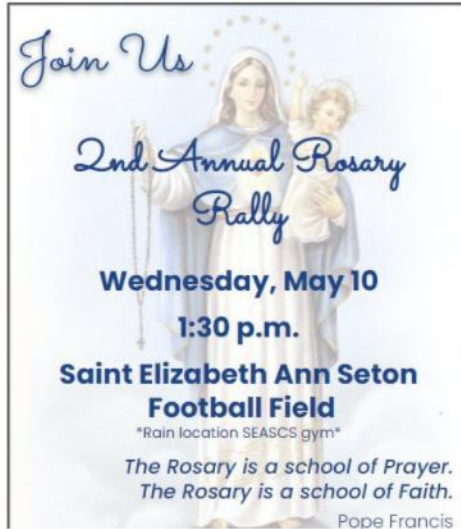

Featured on the program will be Nicholas Schmelter of Caro, Michigan on the organ, and Tyler Kivel of Chicago, Illinois at the piano.

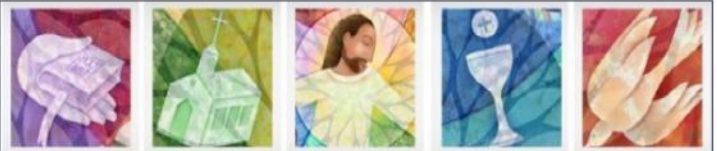

Father Terry hosted Bishop Rhoades for a small, private unveiling of the 1:1 replica of the Pieta brought to our church by Arte Divine. A public unveiling will occur after the 4:30pm Mass on Saturday night, March 25 - the Feast of the Annunciation! Only 100 of these replicas are authorized by the Vatican to be made. They are made using a mold of the original. The same marble that the original was carved from has been pulverized and mixed into the resin that these 100 statues are made from.
