### THIS IS OUR FAITH

Hallelujah, He is risen as he promised! Jesus told his disciples many times that he would be rejected by the religious leaders of their time, be rejected, crucified, and die, but on the third day would rise. Today that promise is fulfilled anew! Every Sunday is a weekly Easter for us as Catholics, as Christians. So today, this Easter Sunday, is the central celebration of our faith where Jesus' glory is revealed definitively and all he said is verified as trustworthy: God is known by faith as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. "Is death the end?" asks every human heart. Jesus' Resurrection is the answer to that question: death is an intermission and a bridge into eternity. The book of Revelation, the last in the Bible, speaks of two deaths, the second being more tragic. In Jesus, we avoid that second death of sin and hell by freely embracing the first death along with Him, united to Him, so that we may rise to new life now, already, but not yet. Jesus rises from the dead so that we can live beyond the fear of death, neither the first nor the second. It isn't merely a promise for the future, but something that transforms us now so that we are immune to those fears.

Every Sunday, brothers and sisters, indeed every moment of every day, Jesus is offering us new life in Himself, with the distinct requirement that we offer our former life to Him entirely. The Paschal Mystery thus becomes our own: dying and rising with Jesus. It is not easy to be a Christian, but it is the only way to find peace. The fear of our hearts cannot be quelled except under the powerful mantle of the victor over sin and death, Jesus Christ. All the world can offer is restless distraction from that fear or lies that try to write it off as nonsense. But the humble and listening heart will not be betrayed by such falsity and manipulation, and thus can only find contentment and peace in the one who appears with his wounded but glorious body and declares, "Peace be with you!"

May the peace of Jesus reign in our hearts as we begin this Easter season. Every year, God desires to make us more and more into the person we are meant to be. Each Easter, His graces are particular and specified for each one of us according to our circumstances and the path that is before us. Stay open to all that God wants to give you during this Easter season. Listen anew with a heart that is attentive to the circumstances of your life, your story of the past year and even since childhood, and let God work in your soul as He wishes.

God is for us, brothers and sisters, not against us. When Jesus rose from the dead, it wasn't to bring revenge, but to bring life to those who unite themselves to Him. Trust in His love and mercy, and His peace will be yours. Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, pray for us!


