CHURCH IS WHERE WE ENCOUNTER GOD

Church renovations are nearing their final stage. Based on feedback from the surveys, discussion with the exploration team, hours of meeting with the architect team at Design Collaborative, and multiple discussions with the parish council and the parish staff, we have arrived at a vision for the transformation of our interior space that has been very well-received so far. It is my hope that you will enjoy seeing the fruits of these many hours of brainstorming, problem-solving, and dreaming about how we can enhance our space. From the outset we have explored three primary elements for renovation, based off explorations that took place nine years ago, to the point of almost being implemented. Those three areas were the sanctuary (raised area around altar and front of church), a choir loft, and a bell tower.

Some of the underlying strategies for the design were: more sacred art to make evident that the Church is where we encounter God; a greater sense of the sacred and experience of heaven in the liturgy; higher dignity to the materials of the space. Over the years, some of this has slowly increased, to the benefit of our space and to the faithful who worship here.

With the desire to maintain the church for worship as much as possible during renovations, we had originally arrived at having two phases of the project. Phase 1 would be the sanctuary, concluding with updating flooring throughout the rest of the church (in stages week by week). Phase 2 would be the choir loft and bell tower, which in proposed designs rely on the same support structures. We are still on track for having a completed project by Christmas, God willing.

Now to talk about the cost. Ultimately, the cost of this beautiful vision for what our church can be is too high for us to achieve apart from a fundraising campaign — which I have promised would not occur. Therefore, the idea of doing only Phase 1 of the project arose as a pleasing alternative. Bishop Rhoades liked this idea when I shared it with him last month. The finance council is in discussion about what is a reasonable amount to be set aside for this project, and I should know more by the time you read this. We believe that due to the higher level of uncertainty in the economy as of late, it is essential that we stay in a strong financial position by the end of our renovations, and so we intend to maintain a significant amount of our annual budget in savings. However, it seems that a large portion of Phase 1 of this project will be doable apart from contributions from interested parishioners, although some support from parishioners would be needed for the sanctuary and entire church to achieve its fullest potential.

Along the same lines, the Pieta statue still is in need of significant funding. While we have the blessing of admiring this sculpture in our gathering area, it is not ours to possess yet. If you are interested in being a part of making this unique masterpiece a legacy for our parish, please contact us.

Colored and grayscale renderings, along with "commentary" from me, will be available in the sanctuary either this weekend or next. Please spend time with these images, entering into the dream of what our church will look like hopefully by Christmas. I intend to schedule one or two presentations to teach and explain about church architecture and the reasons for these renovations and to hopefully answer any questions, which could also be a great help to the project.

Ever wonder what the word "Mass" means?

Originally the term "Mass in Latin is missa, a word in ecclesiastical Latin formula (ite, missa est). In English EWTN notes that in the early days of the Church catechumens were invited to leave after the gospel and sermon were finished and that it translates to, "Go, it is sent," or as defined in Webster's New Universal Unabridged Dictionary, "Go, the congregation is dismissed". As it is plainly laid out in Matthew 28:19-20 "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son and of the holy spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age."
