My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It is always a joy to write to you in this column, a joy to express to you my great joy of this Easter season and the amazing kindnesses God has been bestowing upon us all. My dear children, have you realized yet that you are growing?

I was leaving a hospital visit on Divine Mercy Sunday and suddenly my heart was moved to reflection of this parish and my time with you here, over what has been nearly three years. I suddenly realized I knew how my own father felt watching us (his children) grow up before his eyes. In nearly three years, I have seen your children all grow taller and stronger and more intelligent (it is a striking experience watching children once babes carried in the arms having learned to run and walk). I have seen parishioners come and go. How I loved to great them, how I was blessed to give them their last farewell. I have seen their families embrace in sorrow and in trust the Sacrament which gives us great assurance.

A parish is a family. When one is successful, all the others are blessed. When one is hurt, everyone else is damaged. It is love that holds a person away from sin, fear of hurting their mother and father, from scandalizing the little children. Families are meant to be grown and protected, for they are precious and give glory to God Almighty. Healing, my brothers and sisters, is here within these walls for the sick and suffering. Strengthening for those who remain on the frontline of the fight (and that is all of us).

It is my great joy to tell you all that you are all the source of my joy. In the last several months, I have looked more and more at the pews and seen more and more clearly the people of God (whom He loves and upholds), and been made to know, that my spiritual children are all alive and fighting. Are all reaching out toward the Lord. I see your growth, I know your hope, I feel your faith. I know you are daily now realizing just who Jesus Christ really is, where He is, and who you are because of Him. Let His Holy Name ring frequently from your lips, and you will know my joy as well. You will come to better appreciate Easter, and this parish.

All glory to Jesus Christ, especially through His Blessed Mother.

Welcome to the spotlight, Mrs. Brown, beloved and longtime teacher at SEASCS. Thank you for all you do for our students and

school! Hello! My name is Tonya Brown and I have been a teacher here at Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic School for 22 years. I started out as a half-day kindergarten teacher, I then piloted the progressive-day kindergarten program, and eventually became a full-day kindergarten teacher. I LOVED every minute of being a kindergarten teacher from witnessing the joy of learning, the triumph of solving a problem, the "ah-ha" moments and circle time to coming together as a family and reading a book together. 
