#### My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Yup, two articles back- to-back (a grand privilege for a parochial vicar if ever there was one), and on this Good Shepherd Sunday the Spirit has prodded me to pen a piece concerning God's most holy priesthood.

If you read last week's bulletin article, you know that as a spiritual father, I take great joy in all of you as children, for a multiplicity of reasons, but principally, because you are becoming more yourselves in Christ Jesus. Fathers rejoice in the beauty and development of their progeny and wards. But the task of tending to you all, oh yes, it bears some analogy to a shepherd.

A priest must see in his people a flock, not of dumb panicky animals, but of his precious lambs. Some have horns to be sure, some will bite, some will panic, some will run (and some won't run when that's exactly what they should do), but each one is a blessing, each one another bit of softness and warmth to be cherished and guarded. When you get in to brambles and thorns, a priest must plunge in as well, what is discomfort to care for the gentle lamb.

I am not a hireling who is in it only for the pay (ha!) nor cheap applause. Each one of you is precious to the Creator, so much so that He sent His only Son to find each and every one of you. And in God's inscrutable wisdom, the Son perpetuates His Presence by taking and raising up from the flock foolish lambs to be in Persona Christi.

Priests must never forget where they came from, nor where they are going if they are to be true shepherds of what God cherishes most on this earth. I know my own weaknesses, my faults, my failings. I know what brings me joy and delight, and what the world looks and feels like as laity. The same stones the sheep step upon strike my own feet (I do not float above them as angels do, as you are all painfully aware). It would be an unbearable burden to be a priest without the Divine succor that is that ontological change. Only God can heal wounds, only God can right wrongs, only God sees perfectly and clearly the path to lead the fallen into the light of a risen existence.

And from where I stand I see the path home. And so as a shepherd, I shout, I call, I direct. I tap gently, I shake firmly, I aim for areas of safety and plunge sometimes into danger to get ahold of you. I rejoice that you are in my care, and tremble at the thought of failure. Stay close, little ones. Listen to His voice.

And if any of you ever get into trouble, me and my brothers will come find you. We will come get you. By God's Grace. You are our honor, our livelihood, our very lives.
