RENOVATION UPDATES

I wrote a lot about the church renovations but realize that six pages makes for a lot to read when you are standing in the gathering space of church. Furthermore, I inevitably overlooked a few things that are important to stress. So I would like to take some time to again try to clarify even more.

Feedback has been extremely positive so far, albeit a bit of a surprise to some who have been here since Haverhill Elementary school Masses and have only seen incremental change in our church over the years since its construction. After three decades, many little changes have been made, but never this holistic and comprehensive, and there are many small ways that the building is showing some wear.

We hope to start Phase 1 before July 1st and finish around December 15th. This is attainable, but things have to stay on track for us to make it. At some point this summer I anticipate that we will have to temporarily use the gymnasium, which I hope to keep to a minimum.

Phase 2 will not be done at this time, nor immediately following, because it would require a campaign to achieve the \$3 million that it is estimated to cost. Perhaps down the road in two or three years, or less if we have some overwhelming support. Phase 2 will solve some of the final persistent problems in minor roof leaking in the gathering space, which occurs with hard winds in certain directions. The roof company that helped with leaks a year ago pointed out that the roof wasn't installed according to best practices, probably in the interest of saving money.

The design drawings are still developing but are mostly finished. We need to work with the sacred art company(ies) regarding the paintings, mosaics, statues, and stained glass windows. We also will finalize some colors in the following weeks.

Before Phase 2 is implemented (choir loft and bell tower), we will have to place the organ pipes and console safely in storage, hopefully on site somewhere. I hope we can find a small "box" organ which I've seen used when I was in seminary and was effective for a large space like ours. The choir will be resituated to face the altar with the removal of the choir risers, using two floor

microphones.

The current stained glass will be safely removed for sale or repurposing somewhere on site, perhaps in the school stairwells.

The wooden "altar of repose" which holds the tabernacle will hopefully be donated to another church that can use it. It is too tall to move to our chapel, and a bit too large for the space.

We are exploring how to enhance the audio as well with significant updates to our sound system, especially the speaker setup. We intend to make that part of this project.

I am sure I missed some things but I hope this helps to clarify more. Let us never lose the reason we are here: to worship God and help others to know and love Him and encounter Him here. As St. Elizabeth said (written on our paschal candle): "At last, God is mine and I am His!" Let's continue to make these words true in our own lives as well.


