## GOD BLESS OUR MOTHERS & SPIRITUAL FATHERS

Happy Mother's Day to all the mothers in our parish. Motherhood is something beyond just giving birth, although that is the primary representation of the great vocation of being a mother. As a "spiritual father," I know that there is also a corollary vocation of spiritual motherhood. I see it in women teachers, nurses or doctors, aunts and grandmothers, tutors or counselors, babysitters and nannies. Spiritual motherhood, paralleled to actual motherhood, provides a space of protection and nurturing for the steady development of the entire person. It is like a womb that protects and builds up the person, as a whole, so that their growth can one day lead to their full potential outside of that nurturing environment. I praise God for my mom, my grandmothers, aunts, teachers, my friends' moms, and so many others who have been spiritual mothers to me. Make sure you say a prayer for those spiritual mothers in your life today.

Speaking of spiritual fathers, our diocese is preparing for the priestly ordination of seven transitional deacons, one of which is from our parish. It is with great joy that we celebrate the ordination of our parishioner David Langford to the presbyterate of our diocese. Remembering back to when I was ordained a priest in 2011, the local church that is Fort Wayne-South Bend was pleased to have two men ordained priests, at a time when some years we only had one new priest. It is absolutely mind-boggling to me that our diocese is having yet another ordination group larger than five this June. We should be grateful to Almighty God for this gift of many priests, although numbers are not the most important thing.

I am also grateful to Bishop D'Arcy, our former bishop (and of course, Bishop Rhoades). Bishop D'Arcy felt it was important during his time to only accept quality men to the seminary and priesthood, even though the lack of vocations foretold very difficult times ahead. When he explained this to Cardinal Ratzinger (future Pope Benedict XVI), our late bishop said that he was confident that quality priests would eventually draw other good young men into the priestly vocation, but that it might not happen during his lifetime. Ratzinger replied that the Church's history often works that way: one man sows, another reaps. This has borne fruit in our diocese, by the grace of God, and thanks to the leadership of our bishops, priests, and the faith of our families.

However, we know there is a very important responsibility upon us all to pray for our priests, that they serve well the people of God entrusted to their care, and that they remain faithful in the daily offering of their lives to the vocation of the priesthood and the salvation of souls. Please help your priests, myself included, to continue to make that gift of self in their lives.

May Almighty God bless Deacon David and the six other men who are embarking upon this vocation of the priesthood. May Our Lady intercede to preserve their hearts in love of our Lord and in promotion of His Kingdom among the faithful of our diocese. May they be good shepherds, and may their sheep journey alongside them steadily to heaven.

## PIONEER SPOTLIGHT



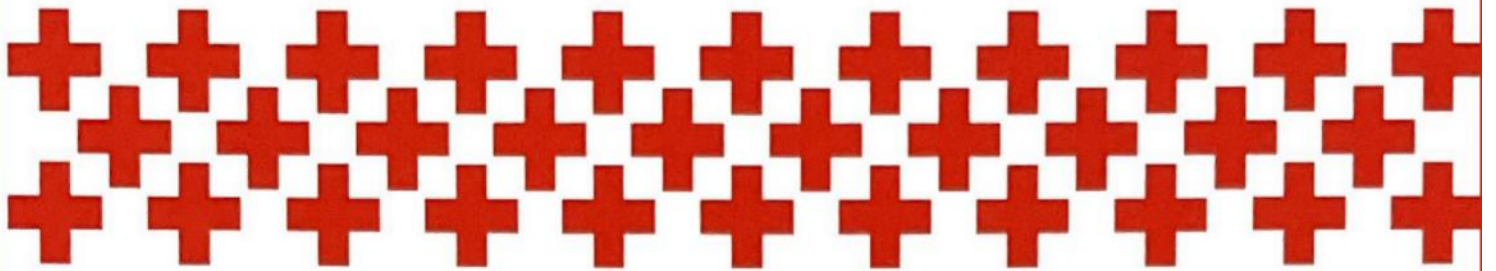
