PRAY FOR PRIESTS

Jesus ascends to the Father, but promises He will not leave us orphans. He will send us His Spirit from the Father to be with us, and by that Gift of the Holy Spirit, Jesus will remain with us always, including in the Eucharist. The Lord also promises through the prophet Ezekiel to give us shepherds, but sometimes those shepherd have to part from us, as the Lord parted from the Apostles for a little while.

Last weekend throughout our diocese, parishes received announcements of transfer from priests who are currently in assignments. This did not include the men who will be ordained early June. For our parish, we heard at the end of each Mass that Fr. Stephen Felicichia and Fr. Luke Okoye will be moved to begin roles as pastors on June 20th at St. Mary of the Lake in Culver (Fr. S) and Holy Family in South Bend (Fr. L). It will not be easy to see these priests leave us because they have truly given themselves faithfully to their ministry here at Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton. They have been fundamentally important to the parish as a source of the sacraments, particularly Mass, Confessions, and Anointing of the Sick. They have given themselves to the role of teacher not only in the Mass but in the school, RCIA, and other programs. We have benefited from their particular gifts and have seen them grow in their roles as well. As a pastor, I will miss them. We shared a house, a mission, and a family here. They were always ready to tackle whatever I asked of them, and I could be confident that it would be done with care and dedication. That's really helpful for someone who cannot bi-locate, especially at a parish where that ability could be used every day!

We need to pray for priests. I mean that in two ways. Pray for the men who are ordained, that they live faithfully in the ministry for which they have been set apart. May they stay close to Jesus, ad have a heart in sync with His heart. Secondly, pray for vocations to the priesthood. Jesus tells us, "the harvest is abundant but the laborers are few. Pray to the master of the harvest that He may send laborers into His harvest." One of the ways we fulfill this command from Jesus is to ask God for priests. Our parish will no longer have any seminarians after Deacon David is ordained a priest in two weeks. The newly-ordained deacons, one year behind Dcn. David, are two in number, when ideally we would have three or four (or more) every year. This parish, for example, had three priests staying very busy, and could easily have enough work for four. However, we simply don't have the priests required. We are extremely grateful to have priests like Fr. Luke from across the globe serving in our diocese so that parishes don't have to close or merge as has occurred across the country. So please pray for priests, those in the ministry and those God is calling to the ministry. Perhaps the Lord is preparing the person sitting by you in Church, or in your family. Pray that they can hear and respond to the call.

And pray for Father Stephen and Fr. Luke. Godspeed to them both!




