### **BELOVED FRIENDS**

Beloved brothers and sisters, the three readings of this Sunday are very short readings but each of them is so deep with the words of a loving God and words of love, consolation and encouragement. Why not? The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity is a celebration of the mysterious and unfathomable love of God for His children. One God, three persons, the consubstantial Trinity. "The Father is that which the Son is, the Son that which the Father is, the Father and the Son that which the Holy Spirit is, i.e., by nature one God" (ccc 253). In the Trinity which God alone can make known to us by revealing Himself as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, "He reveals His fatherly omnipotence by the way he takes care of our needs; by the filial adoption that he gives us..., finally by his infinite mercy" (ccc 270). On Mount Sinai in the first reading of today, God came down in a cloud and proclaimed his name; "the Lord, the Lord, merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity". In the gospel, we hear about the love of God for the whole world and his gift of his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.

The month of June has more of such celebrations of God's love. Pentecost missed the month of June this year, but here we are on Trinity Sunday. The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) will follow. The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and The Immaculate Heart of Mary still falls within the month of June. I am not being selfish because I was born in June:), but June happens to be the month I love the most because of all these celebrations. I know most of our kids will like it too because they are free from school:) Summer also officially begins in June and thank God, we can freely go out and enjoy the sun without fear of snow. And come to think of it, we usually will have out new priests in the month of June, and right here in our midst today is our own brother and new priest, Fr. David Langford. To God be the glory.

I came to St Elizabeth parish on June 5th 2021 and I am ever grateful to God for the gift of all of you. This may be my last article to you as a vicar here but know that your love for me and my brother Fr Stephen will remain indelible in our hearts. We shall resume at our new parishes on the 20th of June which happens to be my 50th birthday. Coincidence or divine? Your guess is as good as mine.
