GOD CONTINUES TO BLESS US ABUNDANTLY

There will be two presentations this week on sacred architecture and our parish renovations. Please try to attend Monday the 12th at 7:30pm or Wednesday the 14th at 6:00pm. Bill Heyer will be present for the Monday presentation, and a recording of his section will be played for the Wednesday presentation.

The Pieta statue is getting closer to being funded. The total amount of \$250,000 is over half-way covered by pledges from initial donors within the parish. I am grateful to those who have made pledges so far to make this gift attainable. As we are getting closer to the final stages of keeping the statue for ourselves and our Fort Wayne area, I need to ask for donations from any and all parishioners interested in being a part of this venture.

If you are willing to make a donation to the Pieta statue, simply write a check to the parish with "Pieta statue" in the memo line or in a letter with your donation (if you are not using a check). This will go in a specific fund for this purpose as we approach the total amount. Any extra funds will be directed towards the other extras for the statue's proper veneration: lighting, kneeler(s), votive candle holders, flower stands, paint, etc.

Thank you for all those who have made pledges. We are grateful for your support that has helped to make this statue a reality for our parish! Through this masterpiece, may thousands of souls grow in devotion to Our Lady and open their heart ever more deeply to the Lord Jesus Christ who laid down His life for us on the Cross.

I am so proud of Fr. David Langford and his ordination to the priesthood. He will do well serving the people of God in our diocese, beginning his ministry at Sacred Heart parish in Warsaw. Pray for Fr. Stephen and Fr. Luke as they begin pastoring two parishes themselves. Finally, pray for Fr. Jake Schneider, who will begin his first priestly assignment with us at the same time. This new priest will be able to introduce himself to you as he gets situated in the parish. I consider it an important responsibility to be a good steward of this new priest as he grows into his priesthood. Fr. Stephen had three years to prepare for pastoring, and for this young priest it may be more or less, but won't be forever, so we must use the time well. Keep him in your prayers and love him into a deeper configuring of his entire person into the priestly life that Jesus desires for him. Come, Holy Spirit!
