TRUST IN DIVINE PROVIDENCE, GOD IS AT WORK

John 14:1 "Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me." Jesus' words at the Last Supper map out a way of life for us as Christians. We are meant to live our lives with a confidence that God is working all things, even the trials, losses, or pains, toward our good (our eternal salvation). Trusting in Divine Providence is always going to be challenging for us at times, and for some of us there may be seasons where it all seems hard. I am sure that is true right now for some of us, as we have another change of the guard among the priests assigned to our parish. Fr. Stephen has served three years here in his first assignment, and will now move to Culver, IN to shepherd that parish. Fr. Luke, after two years in his first U.S. assignment as a "missionary," will also be pastor in western South Bend, IN. Fr. Jake Schneider will begin his assignment here as a newly-ordained priest.

All three of these men are called to live with trust in Divine Providence. So too for all of us who bear the name of Christian. With confidence in God's guidance up to this point in their lives, and in our own, we look forward in hope to what God is doing. His work is never done, and His plans, though seemingly thwarted at times (as in the Cross), ultimately bear good fruit: "And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28

Our rectory continues to have revolving doors. Fr. Vincent Onunkwo has finished his chaplain training here, and is preparing to serve at a Catholic hospital in Indianapolis as chaplain. Please pray for him as he makes preparations for his move (he is just finishing a nice vacation before starting). And we have also welcomed another priest in residence for a brief time. Fr. Lawrence Teteh, of the Congregation of the Holy Spirit, will be living with us for about four months, returning to Nigeria in October. Fr. Lawrence was stationed in St. Therese here in Fort Wayne until his retirement a few years ago. He has returned for a brief time to be with the many people he knows here, to rest and pray, and to offer help to the diocese as needed. Bishop and the diocesan Vicar for Clergy (my brother!) thought of us as a good place of hospitality for him, also aware that we could use the help. I am grateful to have a good and holy priest in the rectory to look up to.

Looking forward, all priests will be attending the Annual Priest Retreat with Bishop Rhoades June 27th through the 30th. Fr. Lawrence has graciously offered to say the 8:00 am Masses while we are away but we will be cancelling the 6:30 am and 6:00 pm Masses for those days.

Please keep all these priests in your prayers as this week is full of boxes coming in and boxes going out, a whirlwind of activity. Didn't someone say summer was supposed to be less busy?! Oh well. We continue to entrust ourselves to God's Providence.


