Thinking about becoming Catholic?



We are now beginning to form our next RCIA Class for people interested in learning more about the Catholic faith. Classes meet on Mondays in the Mother Teresa room from 6 pm to 8 pm beginning Monday, September 11.

RCIA classes offer a way for a person to learn about the Catholic faith in a no pressure environment. Priests, team members, and sponsors are present to introduce participants to basic Catholic beliefs and form lasting friendships. Participants also build community with others going through the RCIA process.

All those seeking to learn more about the Catholic faith are invited to attend including:

- An unbaptized adult
- A baptized non-Catholic adult who wishes to learn more about the Catholic faith
- A baptized Catholic who has not celebrated the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist (Communion)

1 What if I am unsure if I want to be Catholic?

That's okay! Many people have questions about Catholic teachings and practices. The RCIA process allows participants to get answers to these questions and to form a sound foundation about the Catholic faith. The format allows for a prayerful discernment about becoming Catholic. There is NEVER any pressure to become Catholic though.

2 What if I am divorced &/or remarried?

Never fear...we still want you to check it out! Since every divorce and/or remarriage situation is a little different, we will discuss with you what, if anything, is needed before starting the formal RCIA process.

3 What is a sponsor and how do I get one?

A sponsor (or godparent for those seeking baptism) is a person who walks the RCIA journey with you as a mentor and attends weekly classes with you. A sponsor should be a member of the parish who is the same gender as the participant and must be a fully initiated Catholic who is living his or her Catholic faith. Sponsors can be chosen either by the participant or assigned by the parish.
