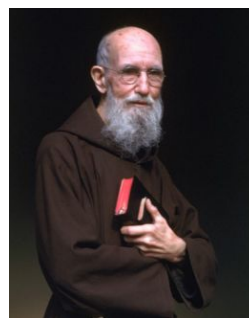

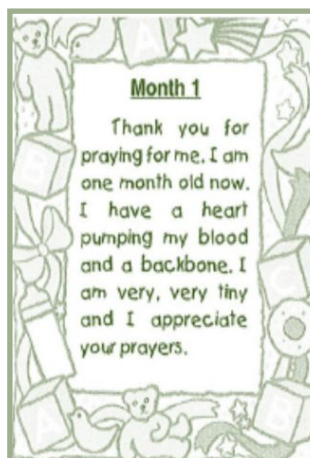


## PRAYING WITH FR. SOLANUS & MASS FOR THE SICK
