What a joy it was last Saturday to be a part of SetonFest. It is hard to put into words the way my heart is lifted up by witnessing the fellowship of our parish community at this annual event. There are so many pieces to the puzzle, and I am so grateful to all the members of our SetonFest Committee who labored for so many months, and even more intensely in recent weeks, to help to coordinate everything and set the event on a path to success. Of course, many hands make light work, and I know it wouldn't have been achieved without the many parishioners who volunteered in those days leading up to and during the event, as well as helping clean up on Saturday. Praise God from whom all blessings flow!

I hope SetonFest gave us all a taste of the blessing of community, especially when united by something as meaningful as our Catholic faith. This means that the one solid thing to build our life upon is the Cross. The world is a dizzying chaos of shifting sand, and to build our lives upon it is to prepare for disaster. Our Lady's grief lasts only three days; her joy lasts forever. This is because she has built her life on the right things. Let us remind ourselves every day that this world has nothing for us, and its fading pleasures last only "three days" and bear misery in their wake.

Hidden in the Cross is the gift of the Eucharist. If we spend some more time before His True Presence in the tabernacle, getting our Son-tan, we will discover the joy that the world cannot give. As we are in the midst of our nation's Eucharistic Revival, some more time resting in the quiet with the Lord will help us to see the truth: the Cross holds steady while the world unwinds.

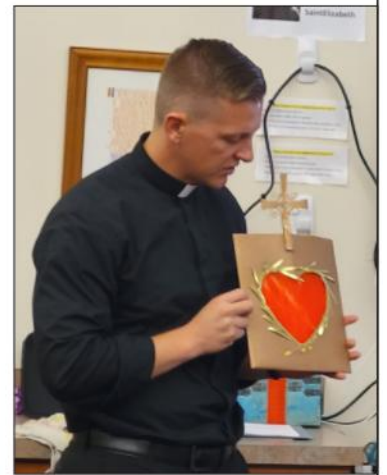
