Did you know that the bishop has a finance council as well, who provide the same service to him for this annual budget and all important decisions it involves? Some of our parishioners, in fact, are part of that team which helps to oversee financial workings throughout the diocese, including our parish's renovations, which required me to present the case before this council and the bishop himself some months ago. It should be comforting to know that many independent and good-hearted, faithful parishioners throughout the diocese have an important role in the work of our diocese and the financial decisions made for our local church under our shepherd.

Your support of the Annual Bishop's Appeal is essential for the continued good health of our diocese. In order for our diocese to continue to function well and to provide robust service and ministry to the Catholics (and to the poor) in our local church, the bishop needs your continued support. So I ask you to please discern well how you are called by God this year to support this appeal. Our parish's goal of \$274K is an important portion of the \$5.1 million that the diocese has budgeted. Remember, any amount beyond this goal is returned to the parish, so contributing to this appeal generously can also mean greater support for ministries here at Saint Elizabeth. Thank you for your willingness to be a part of God's work in our diocese under the leadership of our shepherd, Bishop Rhoades. May God bless the work of our hands!






BAPTISMAL PREP CLASS






