TAKE TIME FOR MEDITATION & REFLECTION

If you have not picked up your copy of the book at the entrances of church, please do so. After this week, they are available to anyone who wants a second copy for their family or to share with others. I hope you are giving some time to sitting with this book by Bishop Robert Barron that is meant to enhance our personal piety and devotion to the Lord's true presence in the Eucharist. I will be giving a presentation on the Eucharist based on this book in early November. So you have about four weeks to read it at a leisurely pace, which is always better than trying to catch up all at once.

The mind needs space for meditation and reflection so that these very deep mysteries can really settle well into our hearts and souls. In a fast-paced world, we often read and think at a surface level, focused on basic meaning, function, and categorization: what is it? What's the main point? What am I supposed to do? What are the takeaways? Spiritual reading is meant to be different.

The goal is to change your person and to deepen your intimacy with Jesus. That is much more than a nugget of information; it is "formation," as we called it in seminary. The goal of seminary was the building up of the man into a person capable of bearing the priesthood in a life dedicated to God and others. We used to say, "your goal in seminary is to fall in love (with Christ)." Spiritual reading, in a parallel way, is about forming our hearts to become more deeply in love with the Lord. This means it can be a sort of prayer, because prayer is a type of loving communion and intimacy with God.

If you invest in some type of prayer or spiritual reading each day, I know you will find life much more meaningful and rewarding. So, why not give it a try? I'm reminded of a small but helpful piece of advice from Matthew Kelly. "Our lives change when our habits change," he would say in his talks, and write in his books. If we want our life to change, what is a habit we can change? What can we do to make spiritual reading a part of our routine? What do we need to remove from our daily habits so that we have space for this to become a new habit of ours?

When you finish this book on the Eucharist, our parish library has many wonderful books for further spiritual reading. Along with those found there, I would recommend a whole lot of books and authors, starting with Our Sunday Visitor, Ignatius Press and Sophia Institute Press. You cannot go wrong with these three Catholic publishing companies, the first of which was founded by a former bishop of our diocese and is located in Huntington. Spiritual reading has done much good for my own life, and I hope it does the same for you!
