

CHANGE FOR THE BETTER

"To live is to change, and to be perfect is to have changed often." This quote from St. John Henry Cardinal Newman is simple but profound. Our experience of life is over years and years, God-willing. This is a real journey, spread across the span of our entire life, where we slowly grow, much like an acorn steadily develops into a large oak tree.

Each year we priests are required to go through a change together. This past week we had our two days of continuing education. During this time of comradery and relaxing from parish work, we dedicated ourselves to intentional study and reflection on our lives as priests serving in the diocese. This year the "classes" were focused on priestly lifestyle: personal spirituality and how our ministry draws us into intimacy with Jesus; as well as personal health and wellness practices.

This is only a short pause that the bishop organizes for his priests, but is meant to be a part of something much greater. We priests, like all human beings, are meant to continually change and grow more and more into the person God desires us to be. And that changes over time, for multiple reasons. First, because we are hopefully growing in virtue and holiness. Second, because our life circumstances are changing, and so our response is meant to be different. So while God wants me to be better than I was in high school, He also has different life circumstances for me to serve within as a priest here in October of 2023.

Life never stops demanding change from us. That is how God desired it to be. So growth is never finished. But how do we grow?

There can be many avenues, but one of the most effective is reading: are we spending any time with the Bible? Do we read anything that helps us to grow in our faith? Or how about a good book, whether fiction or non-fiction, that allows us to enter more deeply into the human experience? All of these can help us to grow, and there are many other opportunities. We could listen to good podcasts or lectures. We can watch wholesome movies.

But besides such pastimes, another great thing to do is to share our spiritual journey with another. A prayer partner or spiritual friendship is a phenomenal way to ensure we are growing in our faith. Do you have someone that you can talk to about your relationship with God? I would encourage you to discover ways that you can continue to foster your growth in the spiritual life. You may not have "continuing ed days" like your priests, but there are lots of ways to grow. Change happens to us all, but positive change (growth), requires dedication and intentionality.

Keep changing for the better. God bless you all abundantly, my brothers and sisters in Christ.
