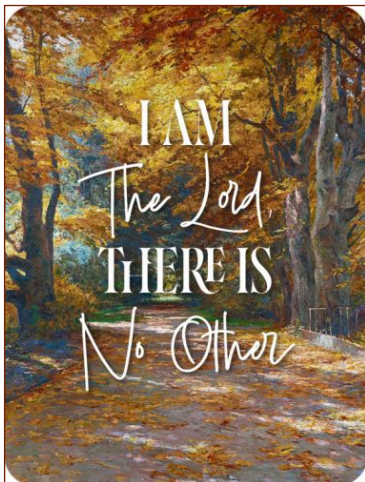

Pray for the Peace of Jerusalem

Pray for the peace of Jerusalem! "May they be secure who love you! Peace be within your walls and security within your towers!" For my brothers and companions' sake I will say, "Peace be within you!" For the sake of the house of the Lord our God, I will seek your good.
- Psalm 122:6-9

Brothers and sisters, these words of sacred scripture take on some new meaning in our own day, with the past two weeks seeing new turmoil in Israel and the Gaza strip, bordering Egypt. The situation has long been fraught with sorrow and guilt and tragedy for all sides, and apart from the mercy of God and profound humility, we are left with a continually increasing fallout of loss of human life. Isn't this the great tragedy of war, indeed, of human conflict at all levels? In this month for the Respect of Human Life, we pray not only for the lives lost in the womb because mothers do not know there is help for them, but we pray for all life that is treated as expendable. We must work against what Pope Francis calls a "throwaway culture" that treats people like candy wrappers. This reminds me of years ago when he mourned the lives lost in overcrowded ferries in the Mediterranean, as well as when he confronted the Mafia in multiple speeches. We as Catholics should grieve for the devaluation of human life in all forms.

So we pray for the peace of Jerusalem, meaning we beg of God for the grace needed for de-escalation, for negotiation and fair treatment, for justice and solidarity to govern policy-making.

Our parish has a pilgrimage scheduled for the Holy Land in early March, under 5 months away, with Good Shepherd Travel. Here is the message I received from them this past week: "You know what's happening in the Holy land right now, we hope and pray that in one month from now the fighting will end and some reasonable solutions will be reached. Many lives were lost in this craziness especially many elderly, women and children. We of course understand the concern of your parishioners at this time but we think it's too early to make a decision right now because the trip is in March and from our experience some solution will be reached within a month from now. Kindly let the parishioners know we are also concerned about their safety and we will not operate any trip to the Holy land if there are any safety concerns still present." I do not think that Good Shepherd Travel will be making a decision about this trip until January or later. My estimation is they are hoping that our prayers are heard by God and a tangible and firm peace is established well before then. I consider this time a good reminder of our need to pray for peace and to live as instruments of peace, justice, and reconciliation within our families and local communities. So let us pray for the peace of Jerusalem, and pray for the peace of our own families and hearts. St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, intercede for us!
