RENOVATION UPDATE

Church renovations are going very well, and almost completely according to plan – which for a project of this size, is excellent, especially as a renovation. Please keep things in your prayers for continued smooth efforts. We are grateful to God for how things progress.

However, I will have to be honest with you: at this point I no longer expect us to have the Church 100% complete by Christmas. However, it will be done well enough for us to have Christmas in the renovated church and it will look and feel great. I just don't think everything will be done, particularly the stained glass windows. We will have to enjoy some extra natural light from some of those windows, and hopefully some of the new stained glass will be installed in others. Our paintings steadily progress, but I also do not expect all of that artwork to be complete – perhaps half or more. We don't want to rush the process of these things that are meant to endure and be of very high quality. Having seen the progress so far in both of these, I can attest to their quality. It is really rewarding to be part of the creation process of new, beautiful Christian artwork. I pray you all find it truly a blessing as well.

The weekend following All Saints' Day will be our last weekend in the church. On Nov. 6th, work begins on the floors and thus pews will be removed. For the remainder of November and the first half of December, this will mean our weekend Masses will be in the gymnasium. I would appreciate your prayers for that to go smooth as well. We are thinking through things and trying to plan, but it will be busy as we set it up for the first weekend and work out the kinks. We have been doing this twice a week for the past couple months with the school Masses, but it will be a little different for the weekend Masses. So on November 11th and 12th, please come in the main school entrance for Mass. Alternatively, you can walk through the building from the church, taking the hallway past the younger classrooms (preschool and first grade). We hope the sound system is working well there, too, for a great experience of worshiping God together as the Body of Christ – just in a different setup. The founding members of our parish are familiar with this, mindful of the days of having Mass at Haverhill school (affectionately remembered as "St. Haverhill"). At least you won't have to bring your own chair to the gymnasium!

I would just like to reiterate your prayers for the parish during this time. It is exciting and really worth it, but it isn't easy in a lot of ways: inconvenience, unfamiliarity, and the emotional challenges that come with change. But we also hold on in confidence to the new possibilities and avenues for growth that this brings. May God continue His beautiful work in our hearts just as we are building up this house of worship to glorify Him! St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, pray for us!




Children's Liturgy of the Word






