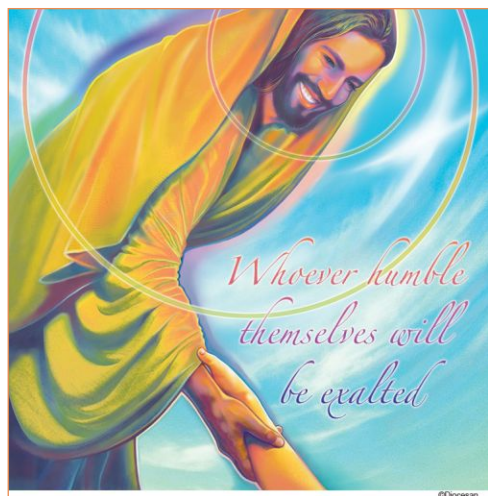

This is our last Sunday in the Church before we spend the next weeks in the gymnasium for weekend Masses. In our own little way, we can sympathize with Joseph and Mary for the next weeks leading into the first part of Advent. The experience is not equivalent, of course. It would have been much harder and scarier for Jesus' mother and foster father. But it is still true: with construction workers busy on the floor, there will not be enough room for us all at this point until they complete things and return the pews to their former locations. So keep those workers and their labors of love in your prayers some more, please! We want to be in a nice and renewed space for Christmas, and as close to finished as possible. We are learning to live by faith throughout this process!

I know Sunday routines are something we like to keep steady, but these weeks are going to be a time for us to really embrace some adventure. G.K. Chesterton put it best for us: “An inconvenience is only an adventure wrongly considered; an adventure is an inconvenience rightly considered.” We will have lots of “adventures” ahead of us during this most intense time of transition. Let's keep our eyes open for where God is going to show up and what lessons He is going to teach us!

The church doors will remain unlocked on Saturdays and Sundays for a warmer walk to the gymnasium for Mass. We know that there is not enough parking close to the gym, so we ask that those who are able to make the walk easily to please consider parking west of church and journeying through the length of our facility. This will allow for more space near the gym for those who need it most.

On your way into the gym (aka “church”), you will be able to pick up your song books and bless yourself with holy water.

The bleachers will be used only minimally. Instead, we will have metal chairs lined up for you in the gymnasium. If you would like to bring a cushion or small pillow to sit on and/or to kneel on, you are encouraged to do so! Use some “holy” pillowcases (or t-shirts!) if you have any!

I'm sure we will have more announcements and adjustments moving forward. But I hope this provides a good sense of how we will make this a surmountable “adventure” for us all. Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, pray for us!

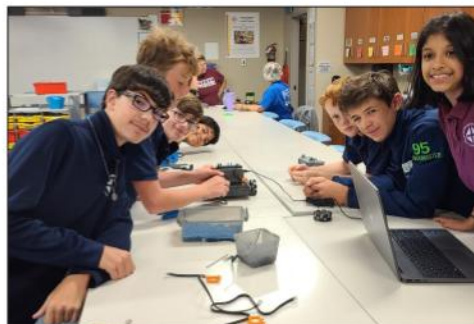
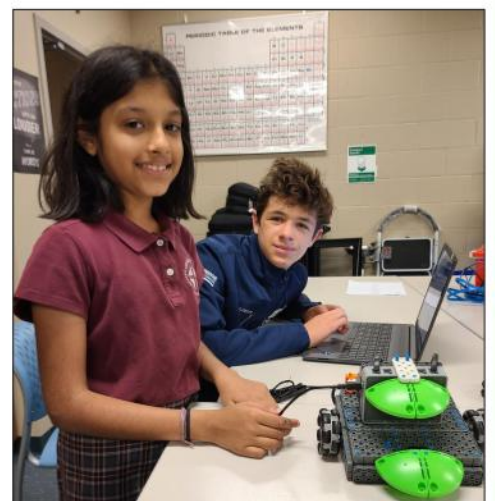
