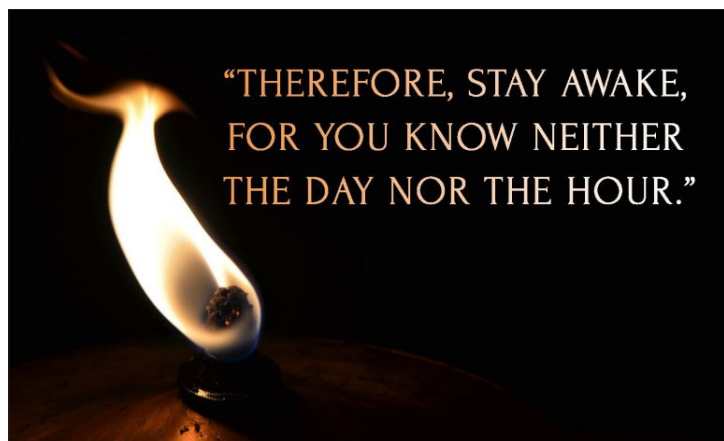

DISORIENTATION CAN BE AN OPPORTUNITY

A sense of disorientation at Mass this weekend, a feeling of things being a little weird, would be a normal reaction to the current circumstances. If this parish church is your spiritual home, then it may even feel peculiar when you are attending Mass at a different parish when out of town or spending time with family. All the more, then, the disorientation increases when you are attending Mass in a gymnasium. However, it is a beautiful opportunity as well.

When we are disoriented, we are given the chance to see things from a new perspective. Perhaps God will use this time to touch your heart with a deep appreciation of our house of worship. Perhaps you will grow more enamored with the truth that we are the living stones that make up the Church, and we can sanctify any place by bringing true and dutiful worship into the world. Maybe God will impart some other ineffable sentiment to you about the Mass and the gift of the True Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

Whatever it is, I think a temporary disorientation can be an opportunity for God's grace to break through in new and beautiful ways. I think it is important for us to share those spiritual insights with each other. It gives us an opportunity to share this journey together, and to benefit from each other's perspectives. So please, talk to your family, your friends, your fellow parishioners about what you learned from this Mass.

Since God is everywhere and He is always up to something good, maybe these weeks won't be so bad after all? Regardless, I will be thrilled to return to our church in the middle of December. And I look forward to seeing the good things that come from our time of "exile" in the gymnasium.

I would ask that you pray for peace in our world. When we pray for God's Kingdom to come in the Our Father, we are really using our words to invoke God's blessing upon this world and to ask that He drive out anything that is not of His kingdom. So please pray for this intention today. I leave you with the words of Pope Francis from November 5th: *I continue to think about the serious situation in Palestine and in Israel, where many, many people have lost their lives. In God's name, I beg you to stop: cease using weapons! I hope that avenues will be pursued so that an escalation of the conflict might be absolutely avoided, so that the wounded can be rescued and help might get to the population of Gaza where the humanitarian situation is extremely serious. May the hostages be freed immediately. There are also many children among them – may they return to their families! Yes, let's think of the children, of all the children affected by this war, as well as in Ukraine and by other conflicts: this is how their future is being killed. Let us pray that there might be the strength to say, "enough."*

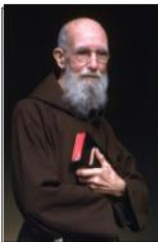
