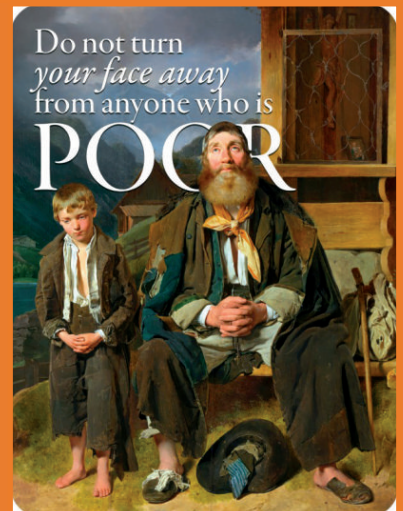

I love Thanksgiving. This holiday touches a true spiritual foundation for the Christian. Religion is said to have its starting point in saying thank you. This is not something we graduate from and outgrow in our quest for “spiritual maturity” and becoming an adult. Rather, this is something that we must live day in and day out if we are not to become spiritually atrophied. I try to make it a point to thank God for things specifically in my prayer journal. Just three things each day, sometimes more, but just sincerely being happy and being lost in wonder about the fact that it didn’t have to be that way, and it is something amazing or beautiful. Your gift to the Scholarship Granting Organization of Northeast Indiana (SGONEI) will enable the school to offer scholarships to qualified families of students in kindergarten through eighth grade. There is no limit on the size of the gift that can be made and any individual or business can make a gift. Additionally, if you desire, your gift to the SGONEI can be restricted to the students of Saint Elizabeth.

Your donation is a WIN-WIN for everyone. SGO scholarships help low/middle income families afford a Catholic education. In return, as a donor to the SGO, you will receive an Indiana state income tax credit equal to 50% of the amount of your gift; in addition, you may qualify for a federal tax deduction for donating to a 501(c)(3), subject to the rules of the tax law and IRS. The following table illustrates how this could work:

For the 2023-2024 school year, 187 students attending Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic School were awarded SGO scholarships to assist them with the cost of tuition. Your gift to our parish SGO scholarship fund will allow us to continue to award scholarships to our students that need financial assistance in future school years.

If you have already decided to donate to the scholarship fund, you have a choice of how to do so. You may make your check payable to SGONEI and designate Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic School in the memo line. The donation form on the reverse side will need to be completed and mailed with your check to the address listed at the bottom of the form; alternatively the donation form and check can be returned to Geanine Morgan in the school office. You also have the option to donate online which is very convenient and easy to do by going to the SGO website at www.SGONEI.org. On the home page, click the blue "Donate Online" button.

Donations for the calendar year 2023 should be made *before Christmas* in order to allow time for the SGONEI to request your tax credit number from the Indiana Department of Revenue (DOR). Any requests received by the DOR after December 31, 2023 will be applied to the 2024 tax year, even if the donation was made in 2023. **The SGONEI office will be closed December 25th and 26th.**
