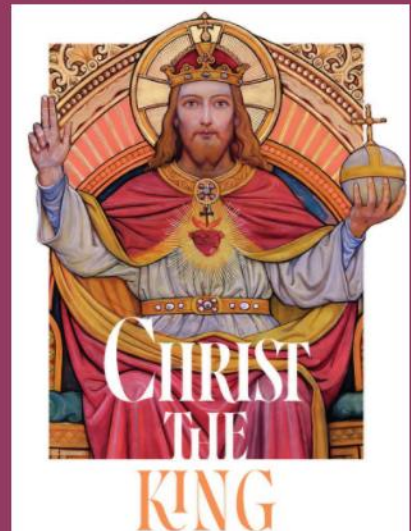

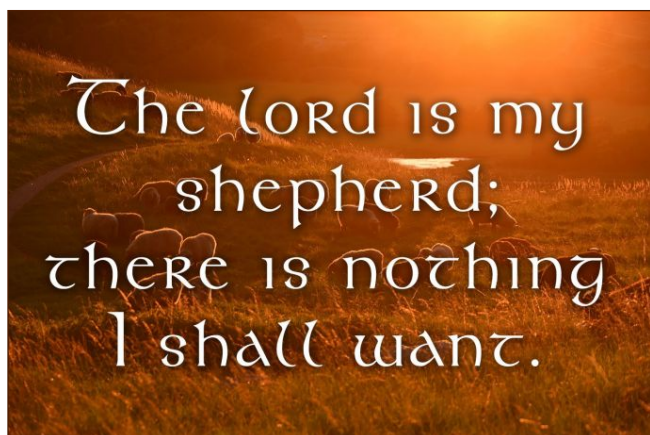

LET JESUS REIGN IN OUR LIVES

I pray you had a blessed Thanksgiving and that this final week of Ordinary Time is also a great time of grace for you. This final Sunday of the liturgical calendar celebrates the Solemnity of Christ the King, although most of America is celebrating the beginning of what we might call secular Christmas. For those who are sincerely trying to let Jesus reign in their lives, we may receive this time with mixed emotions, especially hearkening back to earlier times when it was easier to see that Christ was truly reigning in Christmas. But alas, the songs we are bombarded with as we dutifully shop for gifts don't speak much of Him. (Mariah was not singing to the holy infant in the manger as "all she wants for Christmas," and that other overly-played song isn't about Him either, since He would never give our heart away, let alone "the very next day".)

Certainly we want people to remember the reason for the season, but Jesus is King over so much more, indeed the universe, so our desires should be greater – and smaller. While we can ask if we do our best to let Jesus reign in our lives, it may be helpful to look at it in smaller portions: is Jesus King of my finances? Is Jesus King of my calendar? Is Jesus King of my morning and evening routines as I wake and as I sleep? Etc. Keeping it small truly helps us to discern well how we are keeping the full picture in mind, and thus doing our part to keep Christ in Christmas.

The famous prayer of Saint Patrick popularly known as "the breastplate of St. Patrick" because much of it is more like a creed and a declaration than a prayer, might better express our goal during this season of "secular Christmas" also known to us as Advent (starting next week). May this excerpt from the longer words of that Saint be our declaration and our prayer today.

Christ before me,
Christ behind me,
Christ in me,
Christ beneath me,
Christ above me,
Christ on my right,
Christ on my left,
Christ when I lie down,
Christ when I sit down,
Christ when I arise,
Christ in the heart of every man who thinks of me,
Christ in the mouth of everyone who speaks of me,
Christ in every eye that sees me,
Christ in every ear that hears me.**

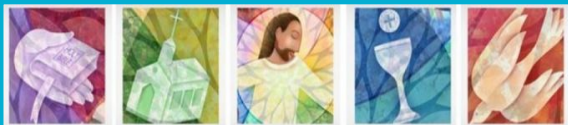

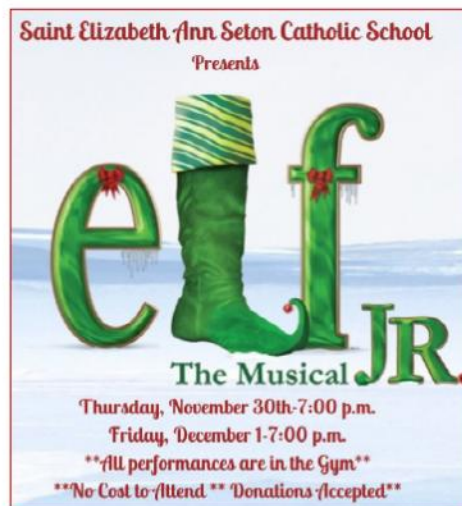
