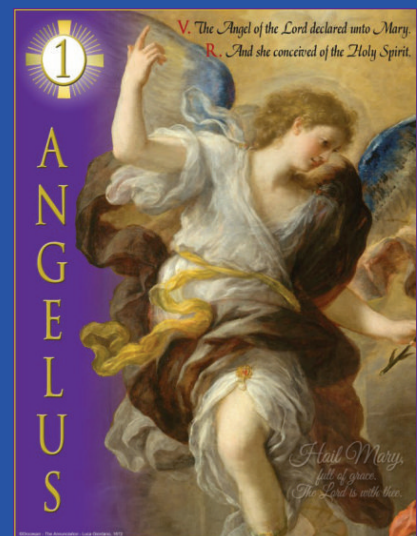

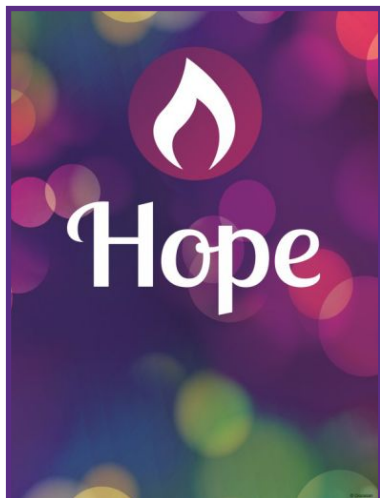

TURN TO THE LORD

We naturally often look forward to things in life, especially very important ones that take lots of preparations. Second graders are looking forward to their first communion. Couples look forward to marriage. Families look forward to the birth of a new child. And yes, now that December is upon, school children (and teachers) look forward to Christmas break. This Sunday, with the beginning of the Advent season, our church's calendar starts anew. As we reflect on the death of the world around us, we look in hopeful expectation for the Lord's coming at the end of time. This final coming also blends with the Lord's first coming at Christmas which we celebrate in three weeks plus one day.

I continue to look with joyful hope for the coming of our worship space, and I hope we all find it to be a beautiful source of prayer for this new liturgical year.

We ultimately look beyond all these various things toward something much greater. "People Look East" is a traditional Advent hymn that invites us to look forward to the Lord who is to come. It is the Lord Himself to whom we must look, for He is the one true hope that we have: He alone can save us from the problems we face. Turning our eyes away from ourselves and onto the Lord in daily prayer allows us to be filled with hope.

At some of the daily Masses during Advent, we priests will offer the Eucharistic prayer turned towards the Lord. We will join you all in looking to the "liturgical East" that is God Himself as we direct our prayers to Him and ask "God-with-us" (Emmanuel) to come to us. And God, in His mercy, does indeed come where He is invited - above all in the Blessed Sacrament. This praying of the Eucharistic prayer "toward the East" is known as "ad orientem" in Latin, and represents how the Mass was prayed for centuries across the entire Roman rite of the Catholic Church. It is good for us to experience this God-focused form of prayer, seeing how the priest joins the people in seeking God. Even if it seems unusual to us, it can stretch us and ultimately be a benefit to our spiritual lives. I know it helps me as a priest to not be distracted by all I see or hear in church.

Let us remember that we all look to the Lord and Him alone as our hope. Let us look forward to the coming of Christmas by preparing our hearts well. O Come O Come Emmanuel!

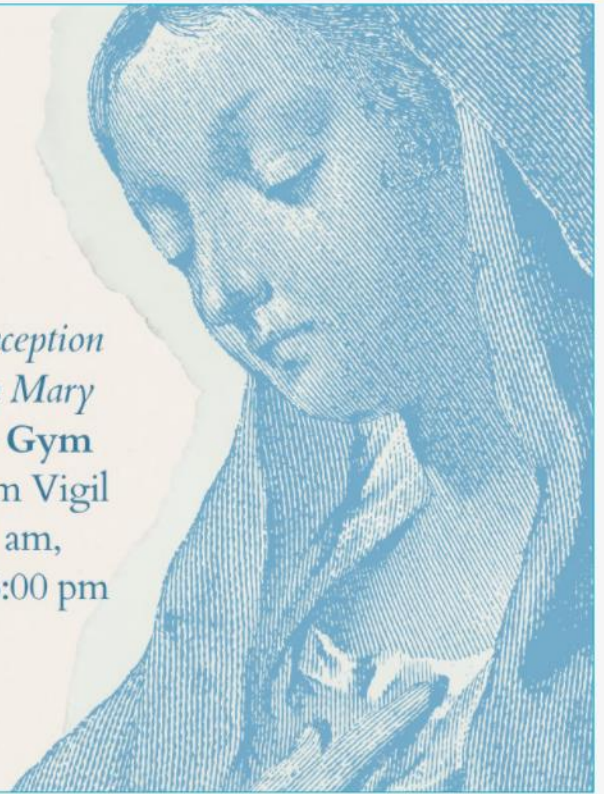

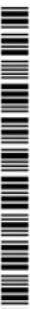
