#### THERE IS MUCH TO THANK GOD FOR

Ash Wednesday Masses will have lots of options. Please try to attend one, or at another parish if more convenient for you. Above all, be aware of the mandatory fast for all healthy adults under 60 years of age – no meat, and only one normal meal and two small snacks.

The Stations of the Cross should be re-installed in our church by the time you read this. Just in time for Lent and the public praying of the Stations of the Cross each Friday, they had to be modified slightly to fit into the new space but should turn out quite nice. Also, hopefully, the marble altar and ambo should be completely installed. They will be awaiting a dedication from Bishop Rhoades in the near future. We will be working with our Bishop to find an opportunity on his calendar, and will let you know as soon as possible. This may be one of the few times (or only time) you'll ever see an altar consecrated, so please try to clear the calendar if possible!

And finally, you should be able to read the scripture passage around church. After the final areas were finished in blue, we can now let the words of Saint Paul guide our worship of God in the Mass and whenever we are in Church. We still have more things to do to complete the project, but it is really breathtaking to see where we are at this point. I am very pleased with what we have so far, and can only say thank you to God and to the many, many hands that have gone into this important work. As we approach Lent, we keep the goal in mind: Easter, the celebration of the Lord's Paschal Mystery and the fount of all the graces we have in the Christian Life. From this fountain many of our brothers and sisters will drink anew through various sacraments: First Communions, Confirmations, and adults becoming Catholic by Baptism or by profession of faith (and also receiving Confirmation and Communion). There are lots of people to pray for. Some of them you may know. Many you might not know personally. But all of them are your brothers and sisters, and they all need your prayers for their final preparations for these sacraments. Thank you for offering up your prayers, good works, sufferings, and sacrifices, for their openness to all God wishes to give them in these sacraments.
