LET OUR HEARTS BE CONVERTED TO TRUE LOVE

Below are some thoughts on conversion and love from a book by the priest Thomas Dubay, titled "Deep Conversion / Deep Prayer."

We use the word love to mean such a wide array of things that it really does damage to our understanding of the word. But Saint John tells us that love is the very essence of God: "God is love." That it's too lofty for much of our uses of the word. Love is one person's self-sacrifice for the good of another, even without attractions or good feelings, even if little or nothing is received in return. It is an act of the will, an interior movement, a choice, that ultimately desires the good of the other. The Cross manifests this love from the heart of God.

We are called to that same love that we see in the Cross. A deep love like that demands profound conversion. It does not happen automatically. Our human nature, corrupted by sin, faces significant obstacles to pursuing that kind of love.

Because our feelings may not be inclined toward this love (of enemies, for example), and because it often makes demands contrary to our own comforts or pleasures, true love often means self-sacrifice in this life. (In heaven, the sacrifice will give way to reward – loving will be easy and natural when we are made saints and free from the fallen aspects of this world.)

This breaks the standards that we often see in a world built upon quid pro quo: "this for that." The gospel demands for love are not just "fairness," but rather a revolution of love, even in the face of enemies or when evil is done to us. This love is so dis-interested that it does not focus on whether the other person says thank you or returns a favor. That is the definition of "free gift" ("grace").

This love only works because of a deeper love that is present in our hearts: a burning love for God, who we see even in the "distressing disguise" of the neighbor who has imperfections, spiritual worse than physical. We love God through them at the same time as we love them as they are, created in God's image and likeness.

The saints are the great witnesses to this kind of love. And their love is truly a revolution. It transforms the world and their ripples continue through history to our own time. Von Balthasar, a 20th century theologian, said, "it is face to face with Christ crucified that the abysmal egoism of what we are accustomed to all love becomes clear." In other words, when we compare our love to the Cross, we see how sad our love is. But the saints persevered in that comparison from one Lent to another throughout their lives, and eventually were able to get closer and closer by God's grace.

Let us allow our hearts to continually be converted to true love. May God, who has loved us into existence, transform us by His love, so that we may love more and more with the same inner fire.



BAPTISMAL PREP CLASS







Listen Everywhere Hearing Assistance system

For our parishioners that used our Hearing Loop system, our parish has replaced that system with the Listen Everywhere system in our sanctuary. The Loop system required listeners to sit in a designated area in the sanctuary. The Listen Everywhere system will allow you to sit anywhere in the sanctuary, gathering area or even the parish hall and hear mass.

To use the Listen Everywhere system, you have 2 options. You can either download and install the Listen Everywhere on your personal device or pick up a Listen Everywhere dedicated handheld device at the welcome center.

For parishioners that would like to install the Listen Everywhere app on their personal device, you will need to connect to the Listen Everywhere Wi-Fi, see the Wi-Fi password below. After the app is installed and open, the Listen Everywhere app will search for the server automatically. Once it queries and finds the system, choose the Sanctuary channel to listen to mass. You are all set.

If you need to use the dedicated Listen Everywhere devices at the Welcome center, you will either need to connect your device either by Bluetooth or cable. Someone at the Welcome center can assist in getting you connected to the dedicated Listen Everywhere handheld device.




