CONFESSION, COME AND RECEIVE GOD'S MERCY

During Lent, we should all go to Confession at least once, maybe more than once. I thought it would be good to explain how to make a good Confession. Your work in this sacrament can be summarized into <u>four primary steps</u>: examination, confession, contrition, and penance. I will outline the basics of what that looks like. May God help us all this season to know our sins and to trust in His abundant Mercy, which compelled the Lord Jesus to die on the Cross out of love for you.

- 1.Make an Examination of Conscience. Try to be thorough, but don't be terrified of forgetting a sin. Ask the Holy Spirit to remind you of anything you're forgetting. Remember that grave/mortal sins must be confessed. Venial sins should be confessed, especially if they have become habitual or there are a great many.
- 2. Go to Confession. Confessions at our church are available after daily Masses Mon-Friday, and then one hour Saturday morning 8:30–9:30. The confessionals are located on the left side of church. (If we have three priests, I usually go in the exit corridor behind the Mary statue. We can also do them by appointment in our offices or can go to visit the homebound for Confession. You have the choice to either confess to the priest face-to-face (seated) or from behind a screen (kneeling).

When you are in the confessional, say, "Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. My last Confession was" If you cannot remember when your last Confession was, just be honest. Give an estimate. The priest is glad you have come to Confession now — he's not going to judge you for how long (or how soon!) since your last Confession. Confess your sins in number and in kind, to the best of your recollection. If you cannot remember, give an estimate, or indicate when something was committed more than once. Conclude with, "For these sins and all others I have forgotten or did not discern, I am truly sorry."

The priest will give some counsel and then a penance for those sins. (You normally fulfill this after you leave Confession)

- 3. Upon accepting the penance given, you pray an Act of Contrition. (There are cards printed out for you to read just ask the priest.) Then the priest will pray the words of absolution over you. Just like a blessing, you should make the sign of the cross at the closing words: "I absolve you from your sins, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Trust in Jesus your sins have truly been forgiven and washed away by these words. The Lord said to the apostles after His Resurrection, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them..." (John 20:22–23)
- 4. As you leave, you may say "thanks be to God." Leave the door open for the next person, and perform your penance immediately or as soon as it is convenient.

An important clarification: there are two kinds of actual sin: mortal and venial. Mortal sin is a horrible offense against God, so horrible that it destroys the life of grace in the soul, and must be confessed. Three simultaneous conditions must be fulfilled for a mortal sin: (1) the act must be something very serious; (2) the person must have sufficient understanding of what is being done; (3) the person must have sufficient freedom of the will. So I cannot commit a mortal sin if the matter is not serious (e.g., if I stole a small amount of money from my employer), or if I did not know what I was doing (e.g., if I were to hurt someone accidentally or unthinkingly), or if I did not act with full freedom (e.g., I was under physical or emotional pressure). A venial sin is one that is not mortal, therefore missing one or two of the three conditions above.




BAPTISMAL PREP CLASS

40 Days for Life Spring 2024 campaign - St Elizabeth Ann Seton day of prayer 3/21/2024




