Fr. Terry's Letter



ALL GLORY TO GOD FOR A GREAT WEEK

What a week we have just experienced. The excellent events of the 40 Hours devotions from Sunday evening through Tuesday evening, and then the altar dedication on the 9th with our bishop, have certainly made for a packed schedule of memorable moments at our parish. With the dedication of the altar, our sanctuary is another step closer to being complete. We continue to pray for the artist's work on the main mural of the crucifixion, with aspirations for its completion before Easter. Then he will begin work on the saints above, "in the heavens." We also hope for one more stained glass window, our third, to perhaps make it for Holy Week. It will represent Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane, which occurred after the Last Supper – such a fitting time to have it newly installed. May God so permit it!

The relic of Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton which now resides in the altar will be present at every Mass. This tradition of including a relic of a saint in the altar comes from the book of Revelation, chapter 6, verse 9, which speaks of the martyrs (the first saints to be venerated) whose souls were seen in John's vision to be beneath the altar and crying to God for justice, and thus the establishment of the Lord's kingdom. This biblical reference explains why we put the bodily remains of God's holy ones (that's what relics typically are) in the altars. We know that God heard the prayers of those holy men and women, and so we unite our prayers to theirs. We are fortunate enough at this parish to have the remains of our patroness within our altar, so that our parish can have her intercession before God on our behalf at the very heart of our worship, so to speak.

Of course, our patroness was deeply devoted to the Lord Jesus' True Presence in the Eucharist. As our speaker, Jason Shanks, mentioned at our second night of 40 Hours devotions, it was in fact the gift of the Eucharist which led the protestant widow Elizabeth Ann Seton to make the sacrificial decision to become Catholic. Knowing it would mean the loss of much of her social network and perhaps family (they in fact left her without support in poverty as a widow with five children), our patroness was so desirous of Holy Communion that she was willing to give up all of these things in order to possess Him, and be possessed by Him. As we approach Holy Week and the Paschal Mystery of Jesus around the corner, what can I sacrifice for Jesus? Did the 40 Hours devotions teach me to sacrifice sleep, "free time," or a certain hobby to make more room for Jesus in my life? Do I need to commit to Sunday Mass even when it isn't easy, including on vacation or other travels? This is something especially to consider with local spring breaks overlapping with Easter. Make plans for Mass if you are away. Don't let it be an afterthought or last-minute arrangement of details.

Please be aware of the special events to come for our parish. Living Stations of the Cross. Our parish penance service. Holy Week special events. Unique Mass schedule for Easter. If you aren't here for the bulletin over the weekend, always remember you can get a digital copy through our website – that way you stay on top of all that is happening. (Travel tip: do the same for parishes you intend to visit while away – check their online bulletins)
