Fr. Terry's Letter



GRACE IS A FREE GIFT

Come, everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; and he who has no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without price. Why do you spend your money for that which is not bread, and your labor for that which does not satisfy? Listen diligently to me, and eat what is good, and delight yourselves in rich food. Incline your ear, and come to me; hear, that your soul may live; and I will make with you an everlasting covenant, my steadfast, sure love for David. Behold, I made him a witness to the peoples, a leader and commander for the peoples. Behold, you shall call a nation that you do not know, and a nation that did not know you shall run to you, because of the Lord your God, and of the Holy One of Israel, for he has glorified you. Seek the Lord while he may be found; call upon him while he is near; let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the Lord, that he may have compassion on him, and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon. For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts. Isaiah 55:1-9 (English Standard Version)


Grace is a free gift. God's mercy is not earned. Heaven is never something we can demand as a right. That is the point of these first words from Isaiah's 55th chapter. God's generous election of the small and seemingly insignificant Hebrews is a mysterious foreshadowing of His free gift of grace to those who know Him more intimately through His Son Jesus by faith in the Church. Do you ever wonder "why did God bless me with this offer to be so close to Him?" This is a cause for gratitude from us all.

Isaiah then transitions into the call to draw close to God and to turn away from our sins, so that God may forgive us. That forgiveness is a second grace, a second merciful gift, that is only known to those who look sincerely on their past and bring their sins to the Lord in the sacrament of Reconciliation (also called Confession or Penance). This week, Tuesday night, is the last great chance for this sacrament before Easter. If you have been telling yourself, "I should go," then now is the time. For those who are apprehensive about Confession, there is strength in numbers: it is good to know that you are not alone in the sacrament, and really encouraging to see everyone ahead of you come away more than just still alive, but manifesting relief and joy at having been embraced by God's love! What could be a better use of thirty minutes on a Tuesday night? Being the Solemnity of Saint Joseph, it is fitting to know that the one member of the Holy Family with his own sins (which didn't stop him from growing into a saint) is also interceding for us to have an abundant confidence that Our Lord does not meet us in the confessional to condemn us, but to save and to heal us.

See you Tuesday, by God's grace.

Finally, Friday Stations of the Cross will be at 7, not 6, because it will be a special living stations performed by our Fraternus and Fidelis groups. You will certainly enjoy this wonderful and prayerful rendition. Plan on it lasting longer than usual, but definitely worth it.
