Fr. Terry's Letter



HOW CAN WE FOSTER SILENCE?

One of Mother Teresa's most recognized prayers came to be known as her "business card:" "The fruit of silence is prayer; the fruit of prayer is faith; the fruit of faith is love; the fruit of love is service; the fruit of service is peace." What ways this week can we foster silence? How can we quiet down our schedule to listen well to the story of our salvation? Let us avoid the unnecessary additions to our noisy lives. I pray this poem will help you reflect on Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem as we embark on Holy Week.

In Medias Res by Paul Hooker "If these were silent, the stones would shout out." – Luke 19:40

YOU who enter the city in the midst of things, come to find a place to love and die, though we are busy keeping feasts, keeping kosher keeping our heads down, keeping a low profile ducked behind stone walls of practiced custom where no hope or change or grace can reach us.


YOU who come to upset our assumptions, take away the illusion that we are the center of things, that we can cushion the stumbling stones in our paths with pretentious fronds and conceited cloaks though we cry save us, save us without acknowledging that we need saving.

YOU who come to tear down temples, overturn the tables of our sacred things; scatter the coinage of our sacerdotal commerce; release the doves we sacrifice to self deception, though we apprehend you without understanding and install you in the harsher sanctuary of our stony hill.

YOU who dwell in the midst of things: for a moment, for an instant, for a heartbeat slow the processional of things; still the noise of things until we hear the one thing whispered in the silence of the stones.

Listen Everywhere Hearing Assistance system

For our parishioners that used our Hearing Loop system, our parish has replaced that system with the Listen Everywhere system in our sanctuary. The Loop system required listeners to sit in a designated area in the sanctuary. The Listen Everywhere system will allow you to sit anywhere in the sanctuary, gathering area or even the parish hall and hear mass.

To use the Listen Everywhere system, you have 2 options. You can either download and install the Listen Everywhere on your personal device or pick up a Listen Everywhere dedicated handheld device at the welcome center.

For parishioners that would like to install the Listen Everywhere app on their personal device, you will need to connect to the Listen Everywhere Wi-Fi, see the Wi-Fi password below. After the app is installed and open, the Listen Everywhere app will search for the server automatically. Once it queries and finds the system, choose the Sanctuary channel to listen to mass. You are all set.

If you need to use the dedicated Listen Everywhere devices at the Welcome center, you will either need to connect your device either by Bluetooth or cable. Someone at the Welcome center can assist in getting you connected to the dedicated Listen Everywhere handheld device.
