Fr. Terry's Letter



THE STORY OF OUR LIVES

The stained glass windows on the northwest of church depict three scenes in the life of Christ. But the bottom panels of each window have three small scenes each. The central medallions are Old Testament corollaries to the story of Jesus above, pointing to how, according to St. Augustine's words, "the New Testament is contained in the Old, and the Old is fulfilled in the New." The scenes on the right are parables that Jesus used in His preaching, such as in the baptism window: "For just as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth." (Matthew 12:40 – ESV)

Finally the left scenes are events from the life of our patroness, Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton. In first window, she is on the brink of converting to the Catholic faith from Anglicanism, as she would sit by the window of her church a look out toward the Catholic Church down the road in NYC, aware of the Lord's True Presence in the Eucharist. The second window shows a domestic scene of her tending to one of her sick children, a reminder that in our daily lives we are able to fulfill the corporal works of mercy in often ordinary ways. The third scene shows our patroness at the bedside of her dying husband. At this point in her life, she was almost certainly praying in the same spirit of Jesus in Gethsemane: "My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will." (Matthew 26:39 - ESV)

I point out these windows because they tell us all something that we are to enter into during Easter season and during our entire lives of faith. It is this: the story of our lives finds its true and full meaning within the story of Christ Jesus' life. The one great Story of our salvation is the story that we all find ourselves within, and that unifies and transforms our stories, that gives them a hope and a future.

Without Jesus' Resurrection, our life is meaningless, directionless and hopeless. Without the Lord's story of redemption, we are left in our sins, in our pains, and in our brokenness. But thanks be to God who has set us free by the suffering, dying and rising of Jesus! The light has shone in the darkness and scatters it forever! In the wounded yet glorified body of Jesus, our wounds and pains find glorious transformation!

What parts of your story have not found their place within the person of Jesus? Bring them to Him this Easter, and allow Him to shine His healing light in that darkness.

The rest of this bulletin shares part of the abundant life of this parish community which flows from the life of Christ. Please continue to celebrate the 50 days of Easter with us through these many opportunities! Happy Easter to you all!






