

RECEIVING JESUS

Our parish Masses for First Communions will wrap up this weekend. It is such a joy to be able to share these special moments with our entire parish family over two weekends. It also gives families a little flexibility to find a day and time that works best for their families to celebrate together, especially if others are traveling from out of town to join for the occasion. The smaller groups also means that children can have their entire family and friends all in church instead of having to contend with overcrowding the limited space for over one hundred other families celebrating (what a great gift to have so many!). Fr. Jake and I, as well as Deacons Rob and Steve, find great joy in these celebrations with our parish family.

In this three-year Eucharistic Revival for the United States, I pray that this experience truly does benefit all of us in the parish as we accompany our First Communicants. We grown-ups had the chance of making our First Communion, and hopefully many since then, but the danger for us is familiarity with the Eucharist and potentially taking it for granted. We may approach the sacrament without truly searching our hearts, and thus ignoring the need to make a good Confession before receiving. We may not pay attention to the one hour fast before reception, or, along those lines, forgetting we have gum in our mouth. (Note: we should not be chewing gum at Mass, especially if we want to receive Holy Communion). Even at these Masses, it is easy to be distracted by the special gift of First Communions, and forget to prepare our hearts for the same special gift that we are receiving in our souls. We can lose our attention from the most important thing and look towards secondary things because they are "new" or "exciting." While we honor our little parishioners, let us not forget to honor Our Lord Himself who waits for our loving response.

Receiving Jesus in the Eucharist is the most important thing we can do all week. It should be the goal of our prayerful hearts throughout the week, and the source of our efforts to do God's will for the week ahead. It should help us to love our families, friends, and neighbors more fruitfully. May we receive Holy Communion always like it is our First Holy Communion, and aware that it may be our last Holy Communion before heaven.


