I pray this Memorial Day weekend is a great blessing to all of you. There are so many things to be thankful for.

This time of year gives us a chance to reflect on important milestones as we see the conclusion of another school year. Our students have just wrapped up their year, and other schools and universities are doing the same around this time. Many among us have received sacraments of initiation. Others are preparing for marriage. Many others are celebrating wedding anniversaries. A few chosen men are being ordained into sacred ministries of Deacon and Priest. There is indeed much to be grateful for as we celebrate so many important milestones. We also remember and are grateful for the many men and women who served our country and helped to preserve this nation. This allows us to rejoice today in the gift of our freedom, most especially our freedom to serve Almighty God and worship him in the Church. Freedom is never simply a license to do whatever we will, unless our desires have been purified by God's grace to only choose what is true and good. Saint Augustine said "love, and do whatever you will." This is because true love only chooses what is good, thus our freedom is always at the service of the true King, the Lord Jesus, who is the way, the truth, and the life. The false freedom of license, without being guided by truth and goodness, is a trap by which our wills end up enslaved in vice. While we may appear free on the outside, internally our hearts are bound up by sin and selfishness. This is the opposite of human flourishing, and the sad state that we see so often in our day and age.

Let us pray for not only external freedom, but more importantly, the internal freedom that is the fullness of freedom: holiness of life, which shows itself in self-sacrificial love. Our parish welcomes a seminarian for the summer. Johnpaul Adizuo arrived in the US about ten months ago under Bishop Rhoades' invitation to prepare for priesthood here in our diocese along with one other fellow Nigerian. They follow in the footsteps of Fr. Augustine Onuoha, who did the same and was ordained three years ago. You will see him around with us priests (he is living with us three now in the rectory) and I'm sure he will be happy to have your prayers and support as he continues his formation in seminary.


SVDP NEEDS YOUR HELP
