THE HOUSE OF GOD

Our first phase of church renovations is nearing completion. We need just a few more pieces of sacred art: two stained glass windows and another large mural for the final white space in the front of church, which will represent the saints selected many months ago. You may not remember which saints we are having painted, so here's a reminder: Peter the Apostle (ancient Jewish); Bl. Solanus Casey (Irish-American); Martin De Porres (half Spanish, ¼ African, ¼ Native American); Jose Sanchez del Rio (Hispanic); Loius & Zelie Martin (French); Elizabeth Ann Seton (Colonial Anglo-American); Kateri Tekakwitha (Native American); Josephine Bakhita (African, many years a slave); Mother Teresa of Kolkata (Calcutta) - (Albanian); Magdalena of Nagasaki (Japanese martyr)

I'd like to point out that one of the main goals was to have a wide array of saints depicted in heaven. We have much of the globe represented, and thus many cultures and colors as well. Three of the saints are younger, though it will be perhaps a bit harder to portray that Kateri and Magdalena were 24 and 22–23 at the time of death (martyrdom for Magdalena). We have priests, religious sisters, and laity. The saints come from different eras of the Church – ancient, renaissance, modern. I'm happy to have a married couple, which is a two-for-one, and it puts the final count at five men and six women. There are so many amazing saints that it is hard to narrow down to such a small list, even if we could double it to twenty (the space also won't permit so many full –sized images).

Phase two of our renovations will require some further discernment for when and how to complete it. Since concept drawing were completed and presented to the parish last summer, some of the ideas have improved. I am beginning discussions with parish council, finance council, and parish staff to look into phase two. If you recall, phase two was mostly "behind the pews" as opposed to phase one which was "in front." We were planning on a choir loft, a bell tower, and a new meeting space above our narthex ("gathering space") behind the choir loft, as well as other changes to make those things work well. We would move the organ, which is safely stored in the basement, up to the choir loft. I miss the organ.

I have received much positive feedback from the first phase of renovations. For so many of us, it was hard to imagine what it would look like – and feel like – in the church once renovations were complete. I have heard time and again that people are surprised and impressed with the changes, and I keep hearing the word "beautiful." Just this past week, a fellow priest said it is "like heaven." That is exactly the purpose of these renovations: to help us visualize what we are told about the Mass and about the Domus Dei ("House of God") – that it is a taste of heaven on earth, the meeting place between present and eternity. I pray that it continues to foster our sense of the sacred and our ability to encounter God in prayer. Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, pray for us.
