

"HALLOW" BE THY APP

I am excited about the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis. Next week's bulletin will share some reflections about the event that finishes this weekend.

Have you registered your children for youth formation classes yet? (religious ed.) This year there is a new initiative we are trying out along with our classes. It's a phone app called "Hallow." If you have a smartphone you should get to know it. There are some things available for free, and a subscription (monthly or annually) allows you to access a wealth of audio content for meditative prayer and for other ways to deepen your Catholic faith. Every family will receive an annual subscription for up to five devices, allowing adults to create a family account that they and their children can use for the year! For those who have children in the school: don't worry; we haven't forgotten you either, and the same great gift will be available to you!

The Hallow app is really something that must be explored and experimented with, because there are so many different things available and they can be adapted to your circumstances or preferences. You can listen to the daily Mass readings or a homily in the car while driving. You could put in earbuds or use headphones while praying at home or in church. You can play Christian music for the family in the home. You can do a daily series, an online course, or other things from "Catholic celebrities" like Fr. Mike Schmitz.

Bishop Rhoades himself has endorsed Hallow for years. So many have found it helpful for their own spiritual lives, helping them relax and stay focused in prayer, quieting their mind and heart, allowing them to encounter God in impactful ways. It's not the only way to experience God, but it has proven very accessible and helpful for people in a frenetic society who need help slowing down. I highly recommend trying the free version now and preparing yourself for what is to come. If you want to purchase a 1-month subscription, that would be a great idea too!


