#### A Letter From JohnPaul Adizuo



#### **EUCHARISTIC CONVERSION AND MISSIONARY CONVERSION**

It was a wonderful and edifying encounter for Christian faithful all over the nation, gathering together as one family of Christ, to adore, and reverence the presence of God in the Eucharist. It is also an opportunity for us to uphold the universality and oneness as sharers in the divine love of Christ, who has given us Himself, soul and divinity out of love that we may have life in abundance.

The experience at the congress was so great and amazing, it is an opportunity for us to revive and reunite ourselves with Christ in the Eucharist, recognizing the divine reality of his presence in the Eucharist, and commending our heart to Him who is the eternal love. At the cost of the congress, I came to realize that love in our midst as Christians is the centralization of our belief in the Eucharist. To intertwine this divine covenant of God in the Eucharist, God gave us Himself as a gift, to renew and revive our heart to that of His own heart. To promulgate this beautiful gift from God, we are called to be a gift selflessly to others in our various apostolate, so that these divine covenantal promises of God may make effective manifest in our lives. The congress is also a way for us to reflect deeply and profoundly on the importance of rekindling the fire of God's love in our undertakings as Christians.

Cardinal Luis Tagle in his homily stated that "Jesus in the eucharist is a gift for us. In fulfillment of this mission, he gave us His Body and Blood fully and entirely". Cardinal Tagle reminds us as people who are to be sent out as Eucharistic missionaries "that the gift of His presence and love for us will be our gift to people. A Eucharistic people is a missionary people". As Christians, who are participants of these divine mysteries of our lord in the Eucharist, to enable this divine mystery to be made more perfect and effective in our life, we are urged and encouraged to open our hearts and mind, in repentance with contrite spirit, so that the effectiveness of this precious gift will be made manifest in our lives, and we would be able to become the true eucharistic missionary in which we are called to be, a gift and a beacon of hope and consolation to people we meet.

In the words of Fr. Mike Schmitz, he stated that "Knowledge can make someone great. But only love can make a saint." As Eucharistic missionaries, we are called to work towards the path that will lead us to sainthood, and we cannot attain this inestimable height without love. This concept should be a way of reminding us as pilgrim people on earth that the Eucharist is not just an intellectual assent to a doctrine, but a profound encounter with the transformative love of Christ. Through the Eucharist, we experience the ultimate sacrifice and love of God.

Listen Everywhere Hearing Assistance system

For our parishioners that used our Hearing Loop system, our parish has replaced that system with the Listen Everywhere system in our sanctuary. The Loop system required listeners to sit in a designated area in the sanctuary. The Listen Everywhere system will allow you to sit anywhere in the sanctuary, gathering area or even the parish hall and hear mass.

To use the Listen Everywhere system, you have 2 options. You can either download and install the Listen Everywhere on your personal device or pick up a Listen Everywhere dedicated handheld device at the welcome center.

For parishioners that would like to install the Listen Everywhere app on their personal device, you will need to connect to the Listen Everywhere Wi-Fi, see the Wi-Fi password below. After the app is installed and open, the Listen Everywhere app will search for the server automatically. Once it queries and finds the system, choose the Sanctuary channel to listen to mass. You are all set.

If you need to use the dedicated Listen Everywhere devices at the Welcome center, you will either need to connect your device either by Bluetooth or cable. Someone at the Welcome center can assist in getting you connected to the dedicated Listen Everywhere handheld device.

Our baby shower celebration will be held on the weekend of July 27-28-2024. We are asking that you consider dropping off a baby item for the WCC and placing in the container provided in the church gathering area. Monetary donations can be made at the Masses by dropping donations in the collection basket or mailed to the church office. Please designate on your check that it is for the baby shower. Thank you so much for your generosity towards the babies in our community!

#### Below are some baby shower gift ideas which can be placed in the big bins located in the Gathering Area:

Diapers, diaper cream, wipes, bibs, toys, bath tub, bath towels, baby shampoo and lotion, blankets, crib sheets, books, pacifiers, teething toys, burb cloths, bottles, socks, onesies, hats, clothes, jackets, etc.

Spiritual Adoption is a precious opportunity to allow God to use you to save the life of babies which is based on an idea by Archbishop Fulton Sheen in which participants pray for a specific, but unknown unborn child for nine months beginning September 9th. Since the child is adopted "spiritually", it is not necessary to identify an actual unborn child. This can be done in a parish or school setting with age appropriate materials. At the end of the nine months of prayer, a baby shower is held to gather items for a local pregnancy resource center or other organization that provides support for mothers and babies. Thank you for your donation to our baby shower as this will help many families in need.




