THE EUCHARIST IS OUR CENTER

I want to look at a special writing today from the early Church. In fact, we have many ancient documents from the time of the bible and immediately following, and they show the church to be centered around the Eucharist (in the liturgy of the Mass). One of these is called the **Didache**, which means "Teaching" or The Teaching of the Twelve Apostles, and most scholars date this ancient Christian text to the first or early second century. The Didache was highly regarded by many early Christian authors and theologians such as St. Athanasius (+373) and St. John of Damascus (+749). The text disappeared and was lost for centuries, but was rediscovered in 1873 by Philotheos Bryennios, Metropolitan of Nicomedia. It is a great treasure to have this glimpse of the early church. (Other ancient texts every Catholic should read are the letters of St. Ignatius of Antioch and the first Apology of St. Justin Martyr)

Here is a section from the Didache on the Mass (Eucharist): ***Concerning the Eucharist, give thanks this way. First, concerning the cup: We thank you, our Father, for the holy vine of David your servant, which you made known to us through Jesus your servant. To you be the glory forever. Next, concerning the broken bread: We thank you, our Father, for the life and knowledge which you made known to us through Jesus your servant. To you be the glory forever. Even as this broken bread was scattered over the hills, and was gathered together and became one, so let your church be gathered together from the ends of the earth into your kingdom. To you is the glory and the power through Jesus Christ forever.***

...After the Eucharist when you are filled, give thanks this way: (This is like the Eucharistic prayer) We thank you, holy Father, for your holy name which you enshrined in our hearts, and for the knowledge and faith and immortality that you made known to us through Jesus your servant. To you be the glory forever. You, Master Almighty, have created all things for your name's sake. You given food and drink to all people for enjoyment, that they might give thanks to you; but to us you freely give spiritual food and drink and life eternal through Jesus, your servant. Before all things we thank you because you are mighty. To you be the glory forever. Remember, Lord, your church. Deliver it from all evil and make it perfect in your love, and gather it from the four winds sanctified for your kingdom which you have prepared for it. For Yours is the power and the glory forever. (This is like the final doxology before we all sing "Amen!")

The Eucharist is central to us. We must always "give thanks." The National Eucharistic Congress, finished two weeks ago, has so many of the sessions available online. Look them up and listen to them. Allow the good fruit from that Congress to multiply and feed your souls and many more as you pass it along. We all hunger for truth and goodness and beauty, which are ultimately found in God, whether we recognize Him or not. Share that true food with anyone who is willing to take it, so that they may be brought closer one day to the spiritual food that is Jesus in the Eucharist, the treasure of our hearts that we, unworthy though we are, are given. Thanks be to God. Amen.

Listen Everywhere Hearing Assistance system

For our parishioners that used our Hearing Loop system, our parish has replaced that system with the Listen Everywhere system in our sanctuary. The Loop system required listeners to sit in a designated area in the sanctuary. The Listen Everywhere system will allow you to sit anywhere in the sanctuary, gathering area or even the parish hall and hear mass.

To use the Listen Everywhere system, you have 2 options. You can either download and install the Listen Everywhere on your personal device or pick up a Listen Everywhere dedicated handheld device at the welcome center.

For parishioners that would like to install the Listen Everywhere app on their personal device, you will need to connect to the Listen Everywhere Wi-Fi, see the Wi-Fi password below. After the app is installed and open, the Listen Everywhere app will search for the server automatically. Once it queries and finds the system, choose the Sanctuary channel to listen to mass. You are all set.

If you need to use the dedicated Listen Everywhere devices at the Welcome center, you will either need to connect your device either by Bluetooth or cable. Someone at the Welcome center can assist in getting you connected to the dedicated Listen Everywhere handheld device.
